



kardia (kar-dee'-ah); prolonged from a primary, kar (Latin, cor, "heart"); the heart, i.e. (figuratively) the thoughts or feelings (mind); also (by analogy) the middle:

KJV - (+broken-) heart (-ed).

Soul

NT:5590

psuche (psoo-khay'); from NT:5594;
breath, i.e. (by implication) spirit,
abstractly or concretely (the animal
sentient principle only

KJV - heart (+-ily), life, mind, soul,
us, you.

Strength

NT:2479

ischus (is-khoos'); from a derivative of is, forcefulness (literally or figuratively):

KJV - ability, might ([-ily]), power, strength.

Mind

NT:1271

dianoia (dee-an'-oy-ah); from NT:1223 and NT:3563; deep thought, properly, the faculty (mind or its disposition), by implication, its exercise:

KJV - imagination, mind, understanding.







KJV - inn.

KJV - fall among (into).

merimnao (mer-im-nah'-o); from NT:3308; to be anxious about:

KJV - (be, have) care (-ful), take thought.

NT:2349 a

thorubazo (thor-oo-bad'-zo); causative of NT:2350; found only in Luke 10:41: to bother, to distract, to trouble.

thorubeo (thor-oo-beh'-o);; to be in tumult, i.e. disturb, clamor:

Needful

NT:5532

chreia (khri'-ah); employment, also (by implication) occasion, demand, requirement or destitution:

KJV - business, lack, necessary (-ity), need (-ful), use, want.

anaideia (an-ah'-ee-die-ah'); from a compound of NT:1 (as a negative particle and NT:127; impudence, i.e. (by implication) importunity:

KJV - importunity.
