

Balaam Inscription



Found at Deir Alla (Jordan) in 1967, the 119 fragments (50 lines) of plaster in Aramaic text was written in black and red ink. Since the inscription was discovered in the rubble of a building most likely destroyed in the great earthquake of the **8th century BC** during the reign of King Uzziah, the text itself must be much older. In addition, the faded ink suggests an older date.

The text opens in red ink (for emphasis) with:


"Warnings from the Book of Balaam the son of Beor. He was a seer of the gods."



nakah (naw-kaw'); a primitive root; to strike (lightly or severely, literally or figuratively):

KJV - beat, cast forth, clap, give [wounds], go forward, indeed, kill, make [slaughter], murderer, punish, slaughter, slay (-er, -ing), smite (-r, -ing), strike, be stricken, (give) stripes, surely, wound.

shaphak (shaw-fak'); a primitive root; to spill forth (blood, a libation, liquid metal; or even a solid, i.e. to mound up); also (figuratively) to expend (life, soul, complaint, money, etc.); intensively, to sprawl out:

KJV - cast (up), gush out, pour (out), shed (-der, out), slip.

perplexity:






