Many well-built ordinary buildings suffer moderate damage: small cracks in walls, fall of plaster, parts of chimneys fall down; older buildings may show large cracks in walls and failure of in-fill walls. | 5 | |
| VIII | Severe | Many people find it difficult to stand. Many houses have large cracks in walls. A few well built ordinary buildings show serious failure of walls, while weak older structures may collapse. | | |
| IX | Violent | General panic. Many weak constructions collapse. Even well built ordinary buildings show very heavy damage: serious failure of walls and partial structural failure. | 6 | |



OT:314 - Hinder



Four Species



The symbolism is as follows:

- The *lulav-date palm* has taste but no smell, symbolizing those who study Torah but do not possess good deeds.
- The hadass-myrtle has a good smell but no taste, symbolizing those who possess good deeds but do not study Torah.
- The aravah-willow has neither taste nor smell, symbolizing those who lack both Torah and good deeds.
- The etrog-citron has both a good taste and a good smell, symbolizing those who have both Torah and good deeds.
