

41 And they departed from the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer shame for his name.


42 And daily in the temple, and in every house, they ceased not to teach and preach Jesus Christ.


### Romans 10:13-15

### The two Enemies - Malaria and Black Fever




Malaria is caused by a parasite called Plasmodium, which is transmitted via the bites of infected mosquitoes. In the human body, the





- Black fever is Visceral Leishmaniasis
- The most vigorous form of black fever is Dumdum fever
- It is caused by a protozoan parasite
- It need not be fatal
  - The parasite travels to the liver, spleen, and bone marrow
  - Signs include fever, fatigue, anemia, and swelling of liver and spleen
  - It is the second largest parasitic killer after malaria
  - The host parasite is sand fly
- There are no vaccines or preventive drugs
- Sand flies are much smaller than mosquitoes and can get through mosquito nets
- They bite when the prey is usually asleep




### Pay Day-Someday








### Bellevue Baptist Church, Memphis Tennessee



December 11, 1927, R.G. Lee preached his first sermon at Bellevue. Upon his resignation 33 years later, in 1960, the congregation had grown from 1430 members to over 10,000. Thought knew brother Lee as a superlative pulpiteer, the people at Bellevue knew him as a loving and caring under shepherd that knew each of them. His vision was broader than just Bellevue...he led the Southern Baptist Convention from 1948 to 1951.
