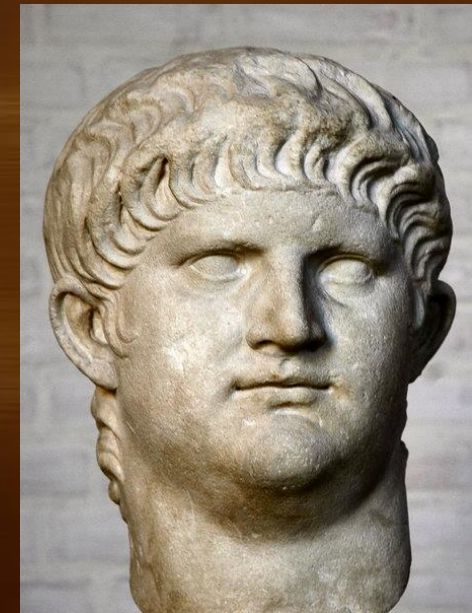

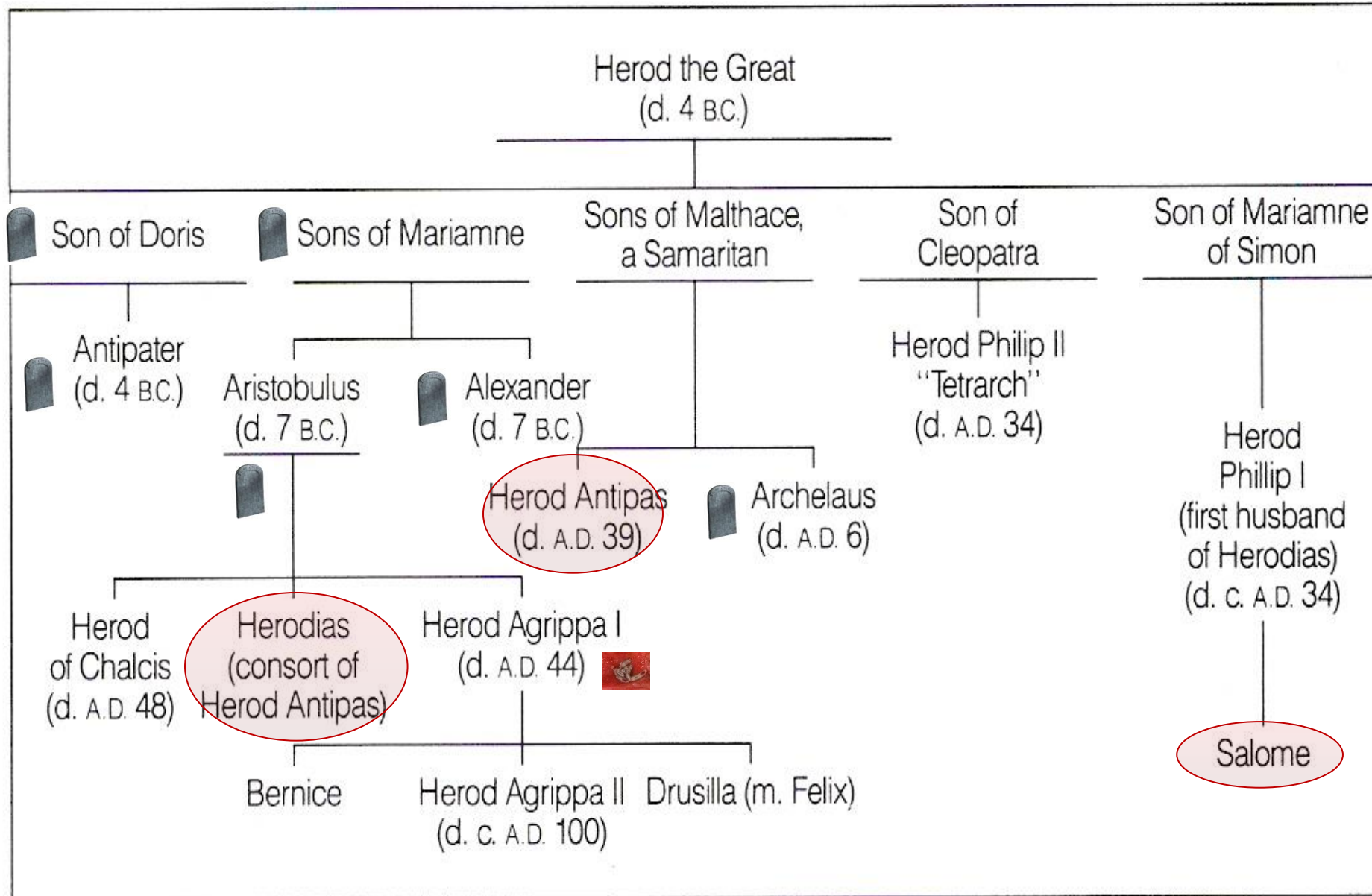

Two Jewish Religious Sects

- Hellenists: Greek influence

- ❖ Sadducees

- Hasidim: “The Pious Ones”

- ❖ Pharisees

Sadducee

4523 Saddoukaïos (sad-doo-kah'-yos);

A Sadducaean (i.e. Tsadokian), or follower of a certain heretical Israelite:

KJV- Sadducee

4524 Sadok (sad-oke');

Sadoc (i.e. Tsadok), an Israelite:

KJV- Sadoc

Luke 20:27

Pharisee

5330 **Pharisaios** (far-is-ah'-yos);

Of Hebrew origin; a separatist, i.e. exclusively religious; a Pharisean, i.e. Jewish sectary:

KJV- Pharisee.

Scribes

1122 **grammateus** (gram-mat-yooce');

A writer, i.e. (professionally) scribe or secretary:

KJV- scribe, town-clerk.

Mark 12:28-34

Lawyers

3544 **nomikos** (nom-ik-os');

According (or pertaining) to law, i.e. legal (cer.); as noun, an expert in the (Mosaic) law:
KJV- about the law, lawyer.

Luke 10:25-29

Doctors

1320 didaskalos (did-as'-kal-os);

An instructor (genitive case or specially):

KJV-- doctor, master, teacher.

3547 nomodidaskalos (nom-od-id-as'-kal-os);

an expounder of the (Jewish) law, i.e. a Rabbi:

KJV-- doctor (teacher) of the law.

Luke 2:46 and Luke 5:17

High Priests, Priests, & Levites

749 **archiereus** (ar-khee-er-yuce');

The high-priest (literally, of the Jews, typically, Christ); by extension a chief priest:

KJV- chief (high) priest, chief of the priests.

2409 **hiereus** (hee-er-yooce');

A priest (literally or figuratively):

KJV- (high) priest.

3019 **Leuites** (lyoo-ee'-tace);

A Levite, i.e. descendant of Levi:

KJV-- Levite.

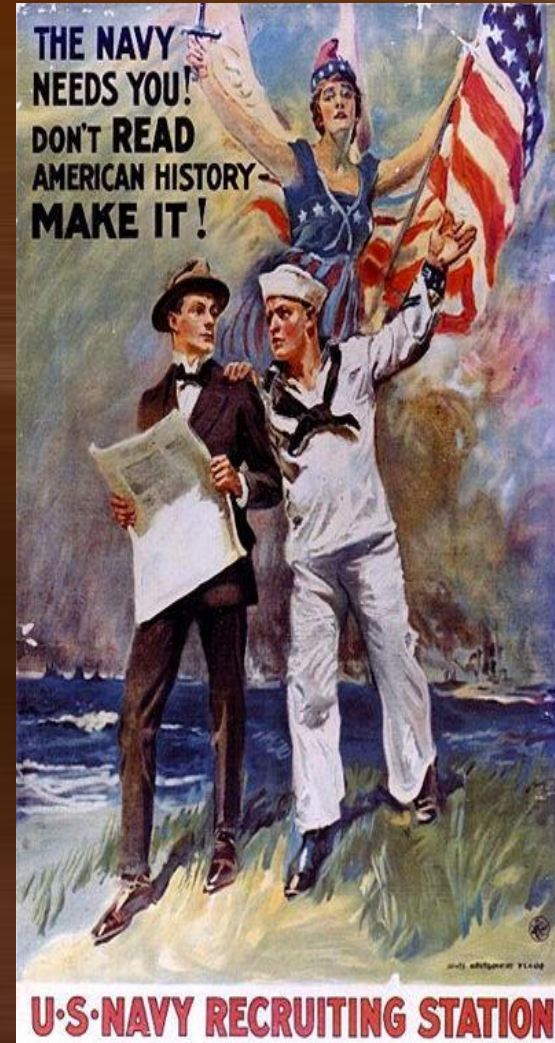
