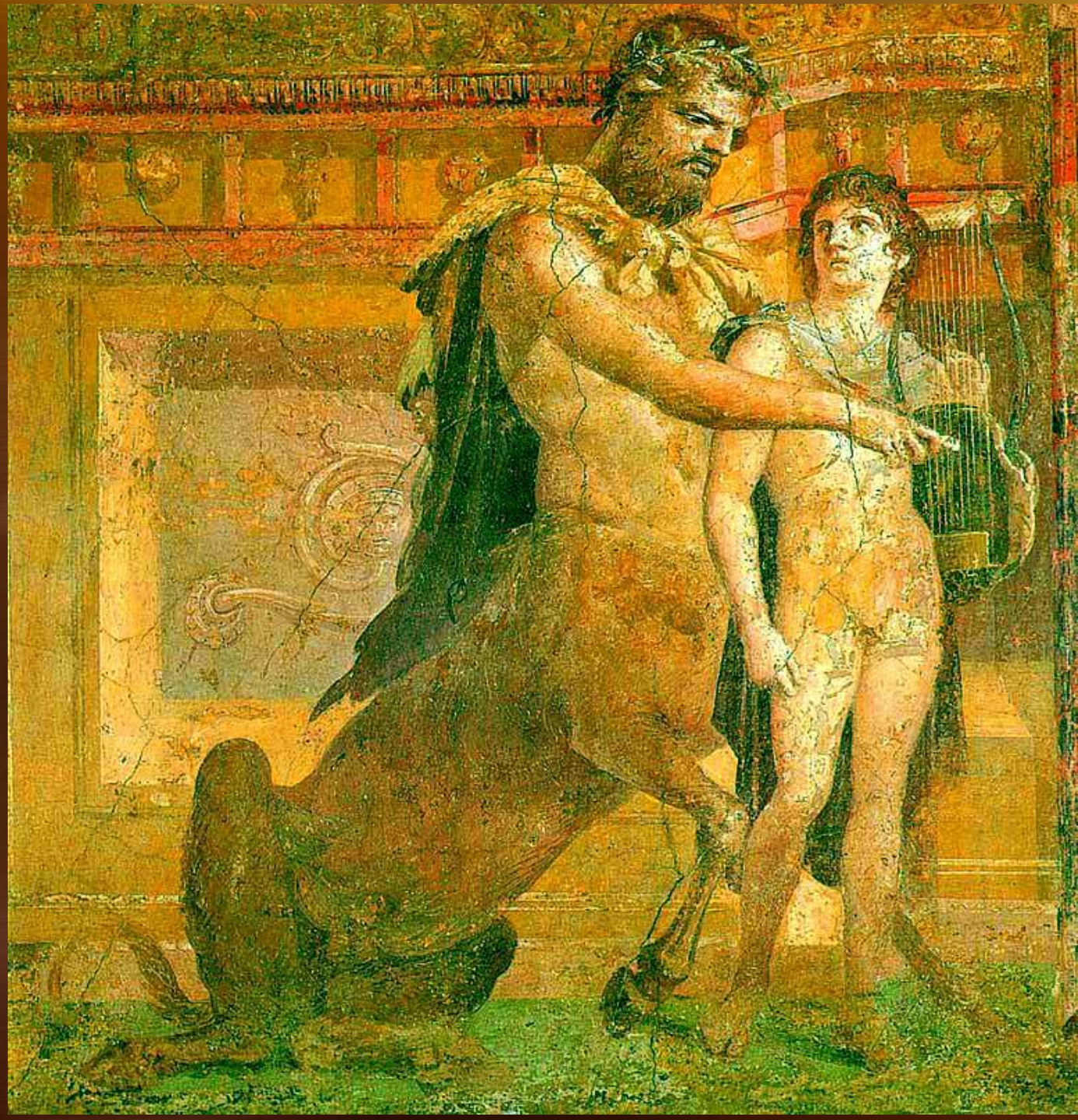
**iaomai** (ee-ah'-om-ahee); a primary verb; to

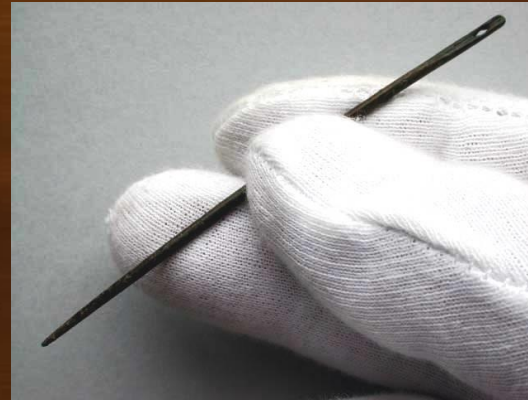

# Theophilus

NT:2321

**Theophilus** (theh-of'-il-os); from NT:2316 and NT:5384; friend of God; Theophilus, a Christian:

NT:2316

**theos** (theh'-os); a deity, especially the supreme Divinity; figuratively, a magistrate; by Hebraism:

NT:5384

**philos** (fee'-los); properly, dear, i.e. a friend; actively, fond, i.e. friendly (still as a noun, an associate, neighbor, etc.):



# “Most Excellent”

NT:2903

**kratistos** (krat'-is-tos); superlative of a derivative of NT:2904; strongest, i.e. (in dignity) very honorable:

KJV - most excellent (noble).

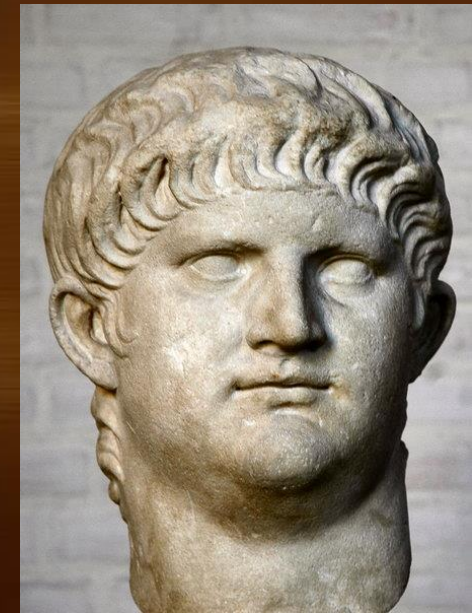

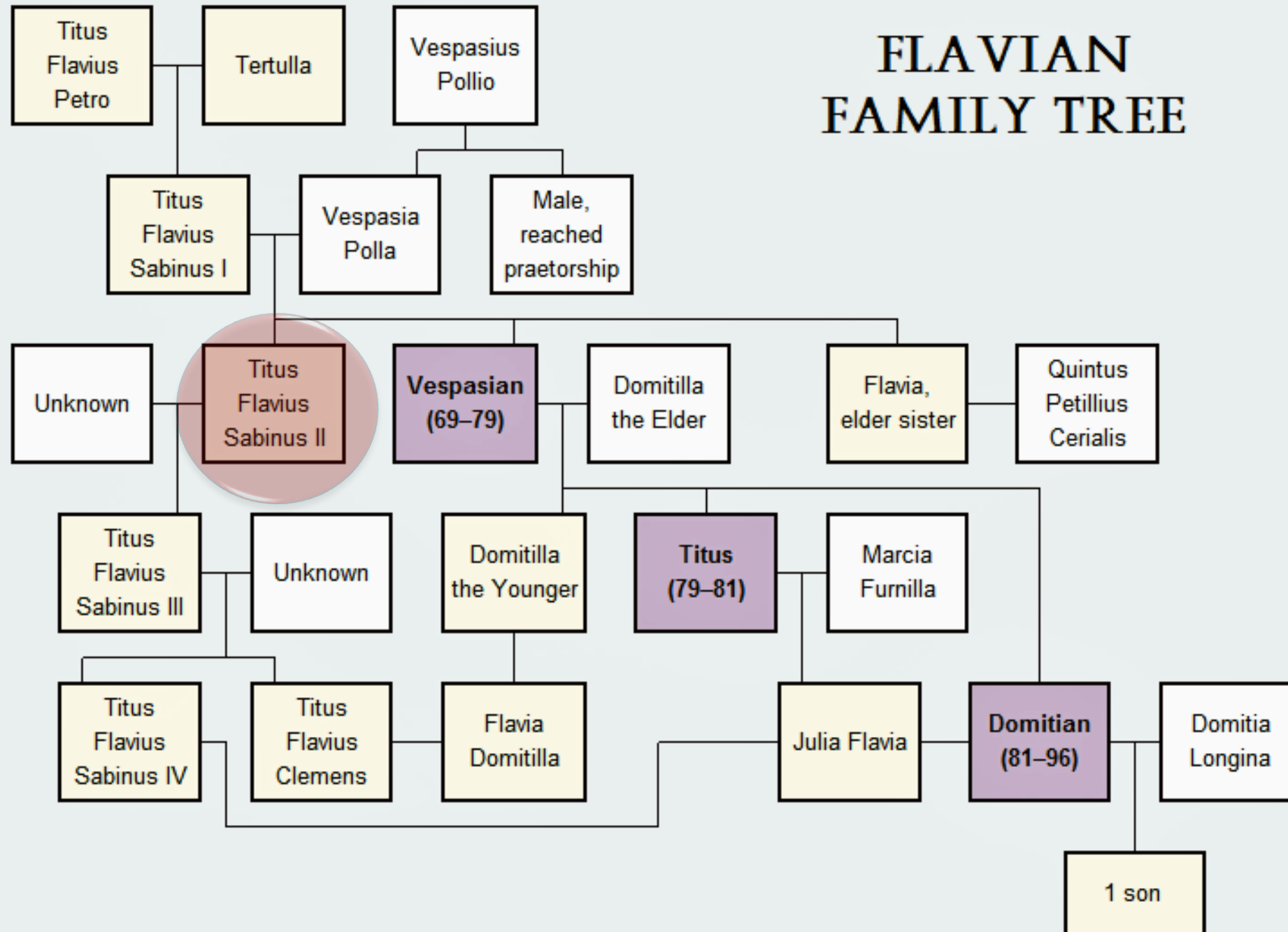

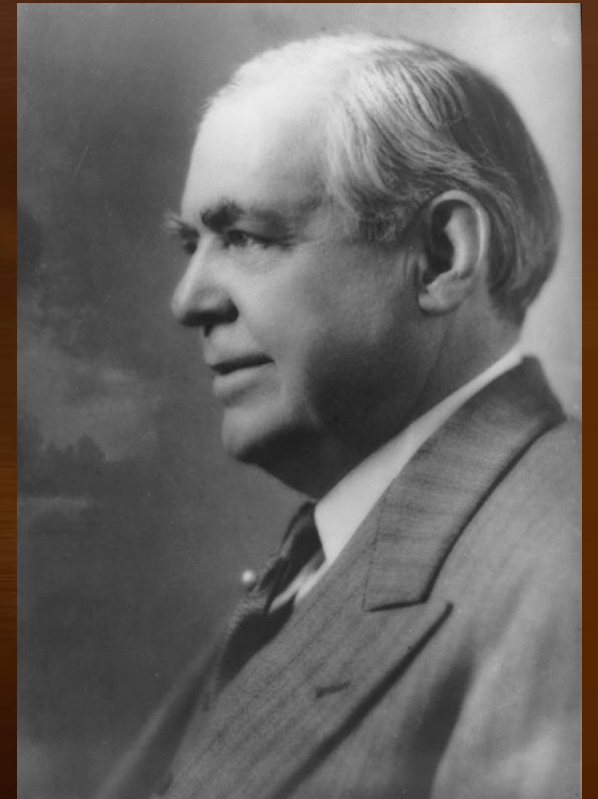
