Council

NT:4892 **Sunedrion** (soon-ed'-ree-on); compound of **NT:4862** and the base of **NT:1476**; a joint session, i.e. (specifically) the Jewish Sanhedrin; by analogy, a subordinate tribunal:
KJV - council.

NT:4862 **Sun** (soon); a primary preposition denoting union; with or together, i.e. by association, companionship, process, resemblance, possession, instrumentality, addition, etc.:
KJV - beside, with

NT:1476 **Hedraios** (hed-rah'-yos); from a derivative of hezomai (to sit); sedentary, i.e. (by implication) immovable:
KJV - settled, steadfast

The terms of Annas, Caiaphas, and the five brothers are:

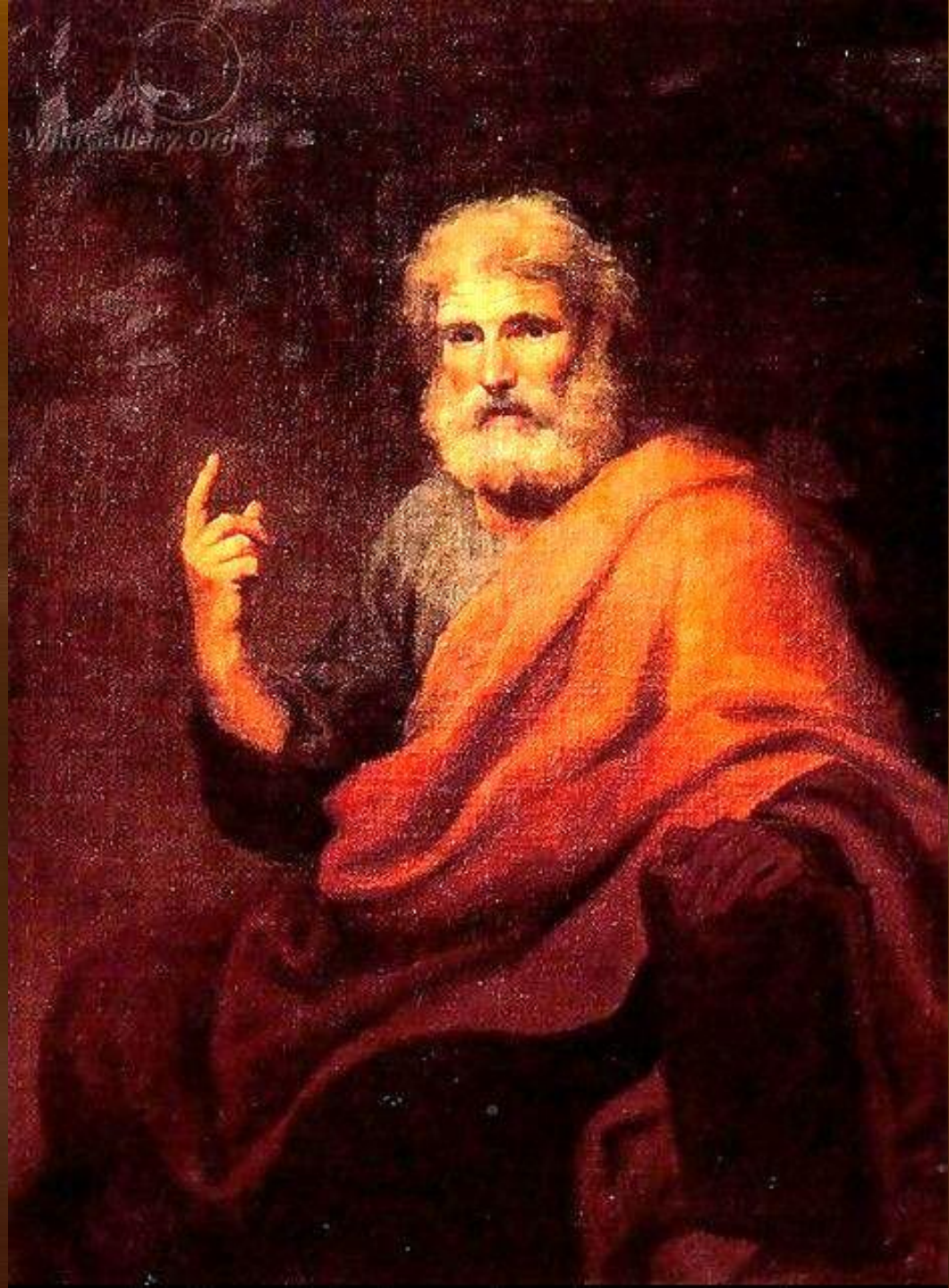
- Annas ben Seth (6–15)

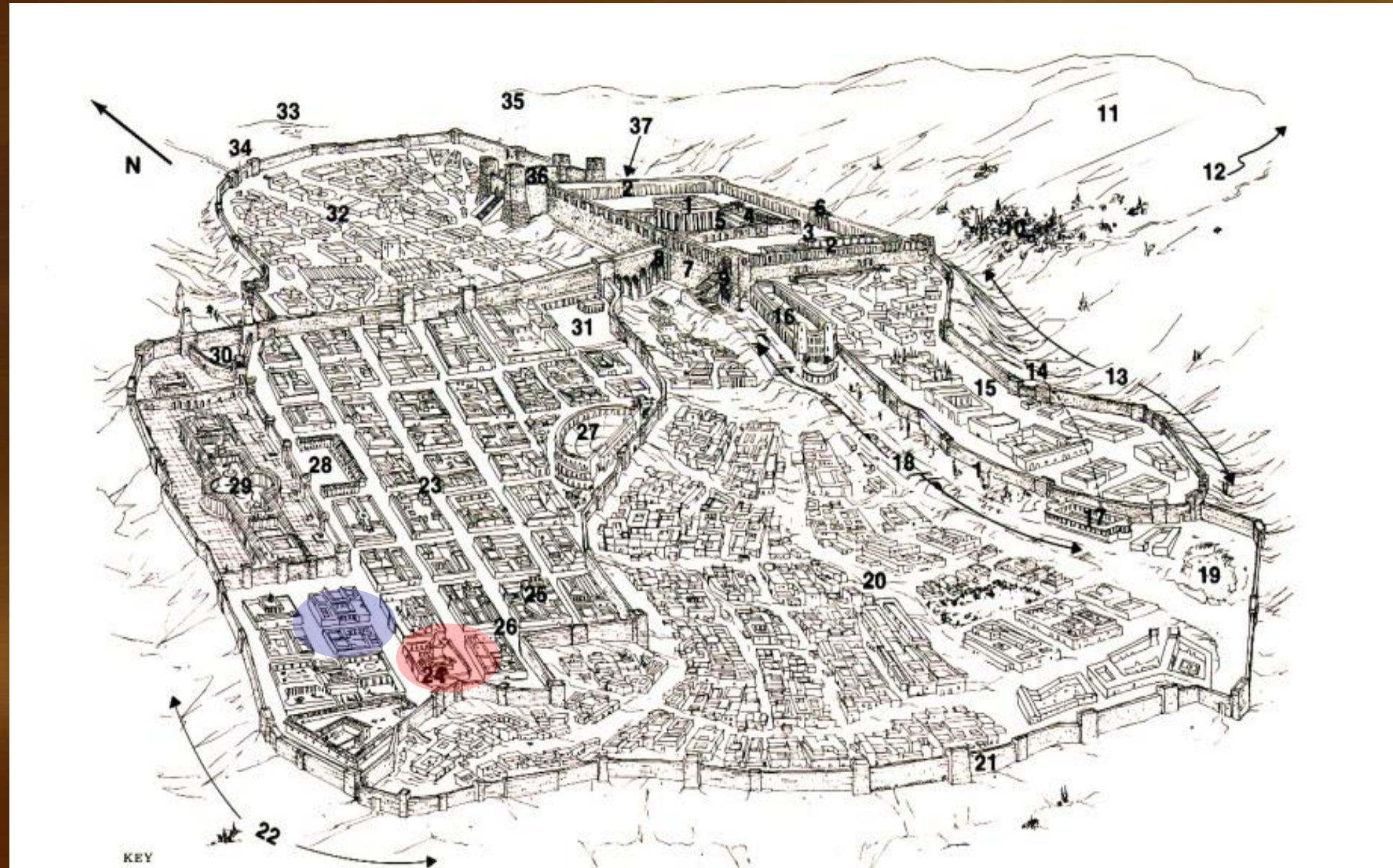

parrhesia (par-rhay-see'-ah); all out-spokenness, i.e. frankness, bluntness, publicity; by implication, assurance:

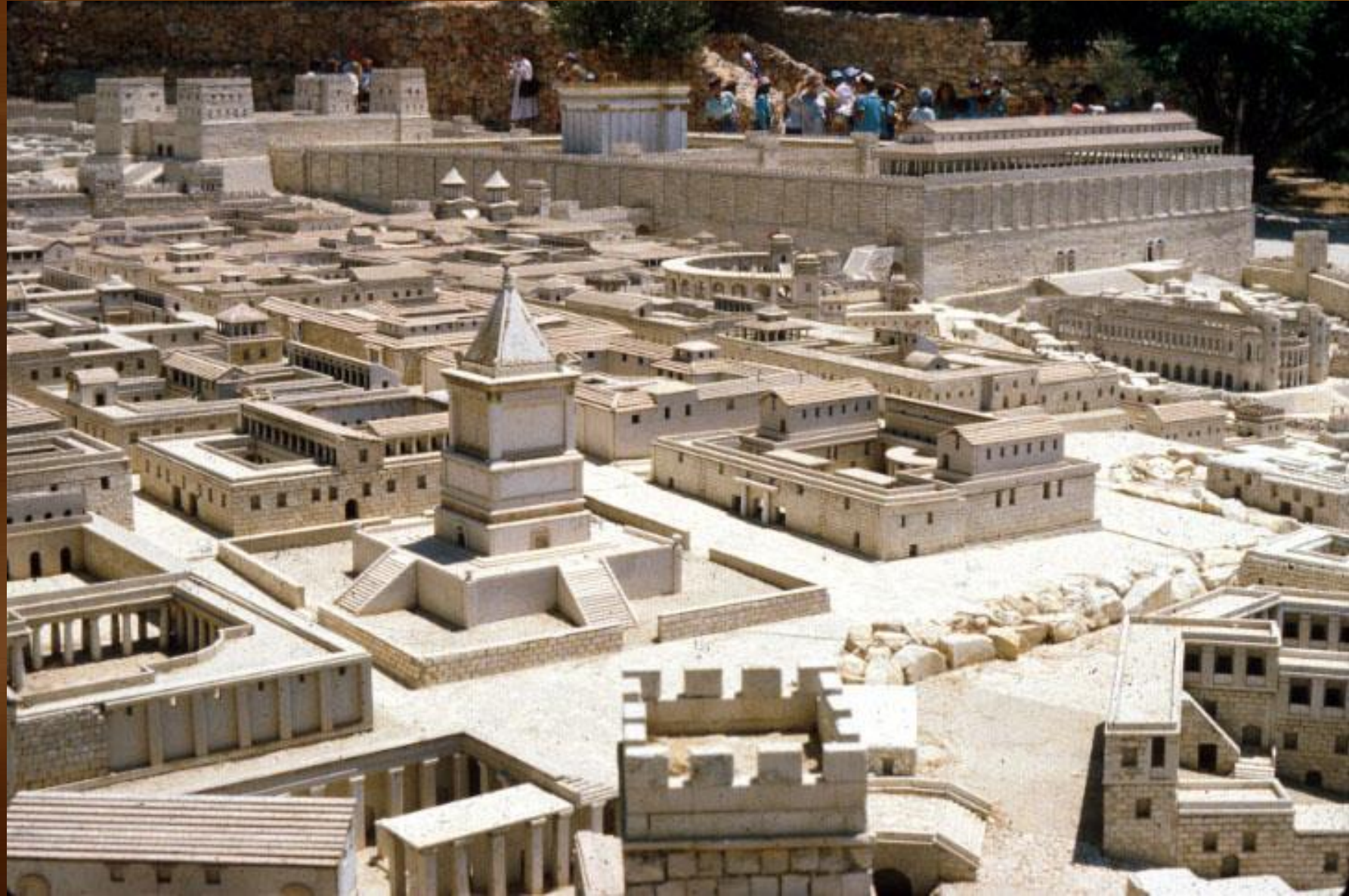

parakletos (par-ak'-lay-tos); an intercessor, consoler:

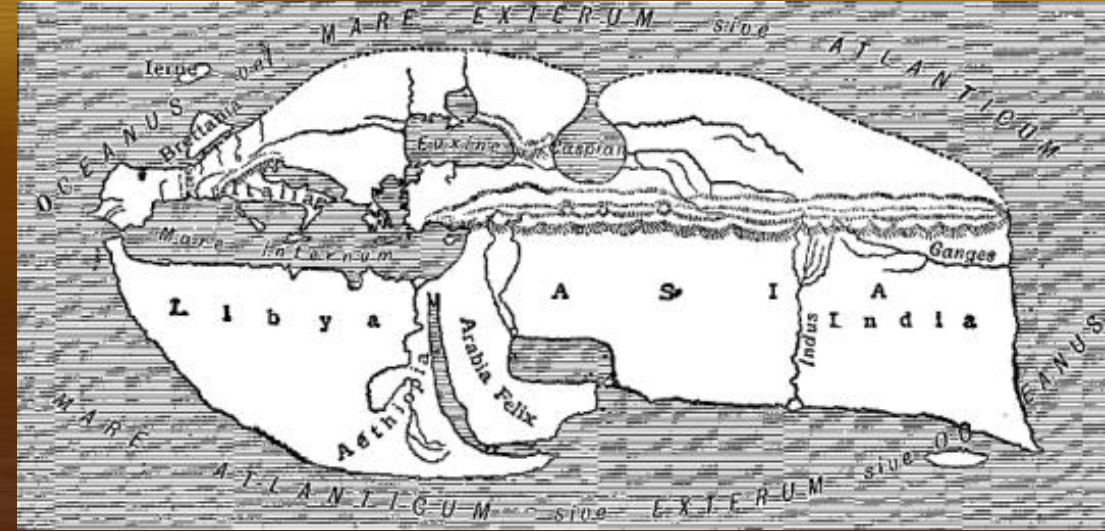
KJV - advocate, comforter.

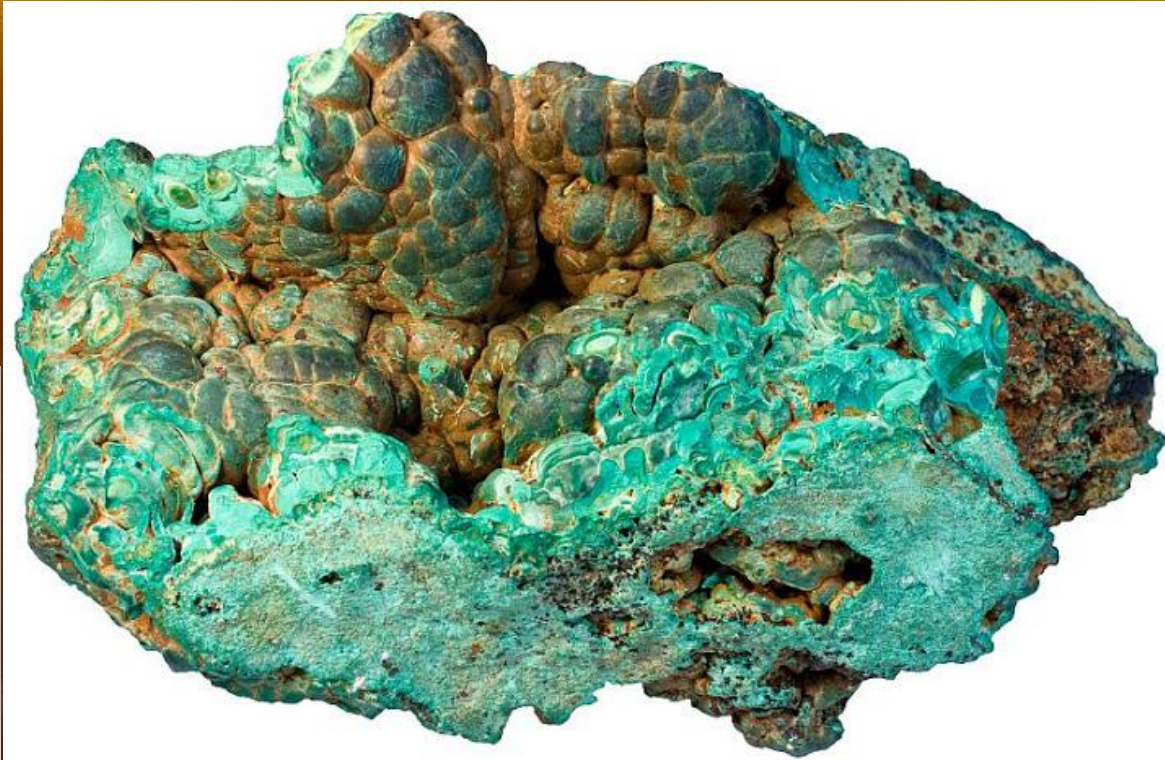
