mageuo (mag-yoo'-o); from NT:3097; to practice magic:

KJV - use sorcery.

NT:3097

magos (mag'-os); of foreign origin [OT:7248]; a Magian, i.e. Oriental scientist; by implication a magician:

KJV - sorcerer, wise man.

NT:1839

existemi (ex-is'-tay-mee); to put (stand) out of wits, i.e. astound, or (reflexively) become astounded, insane:

KJV - amaze, be (make) astonished, be besideself (selves), bewitch, wonder.

Gall of Bitterness

NT:5521

chole (khol-ay'); (from the greenish hue); "gall" or bile, i.e. (by analogy) poison or an anodyne (wormwood, poppy, etc.):

KJV - gall.

NT:4088

pikria (pik-ree'-ah); from NT:4089; acridity (especially poison), literally or figuratively:

KJV - bitterness.

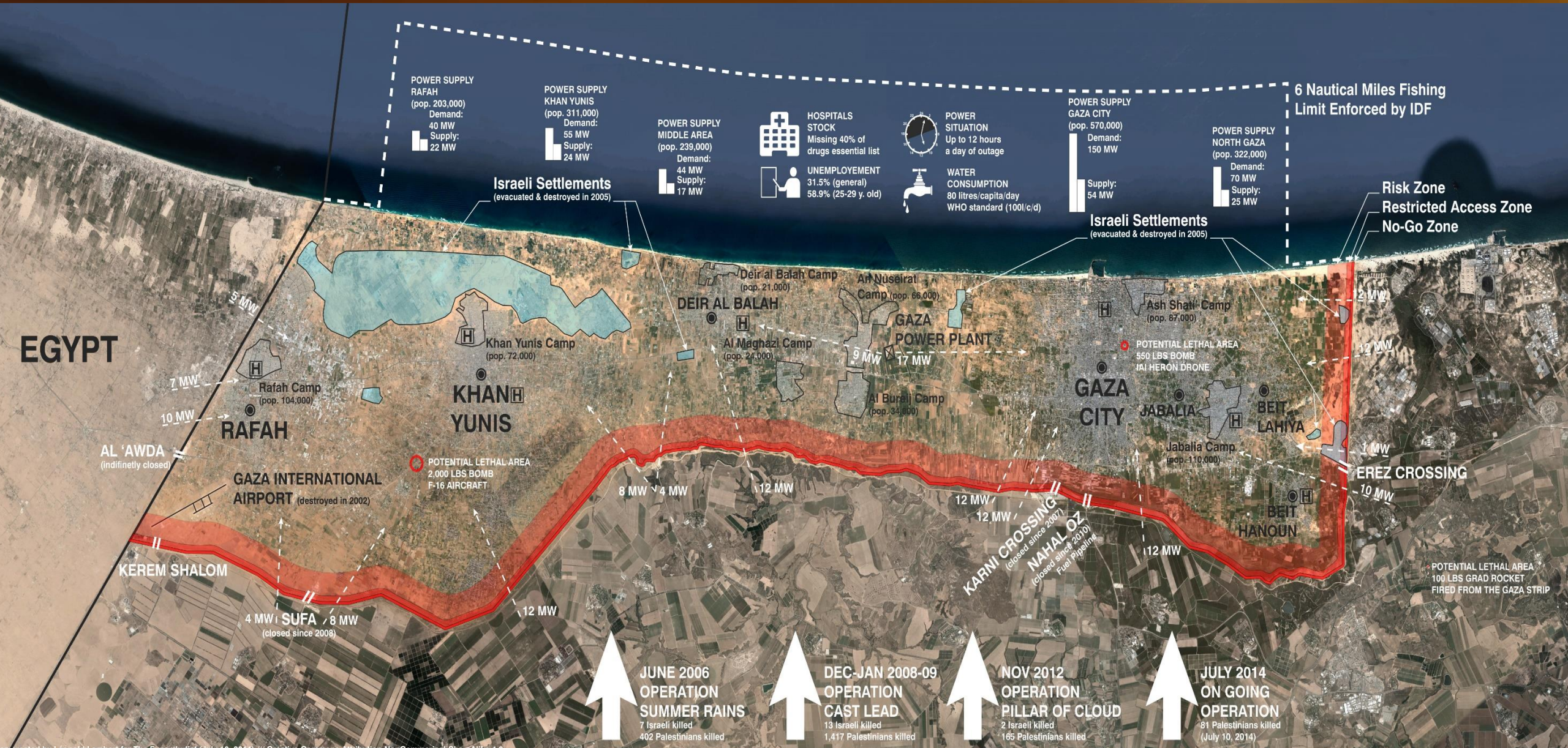

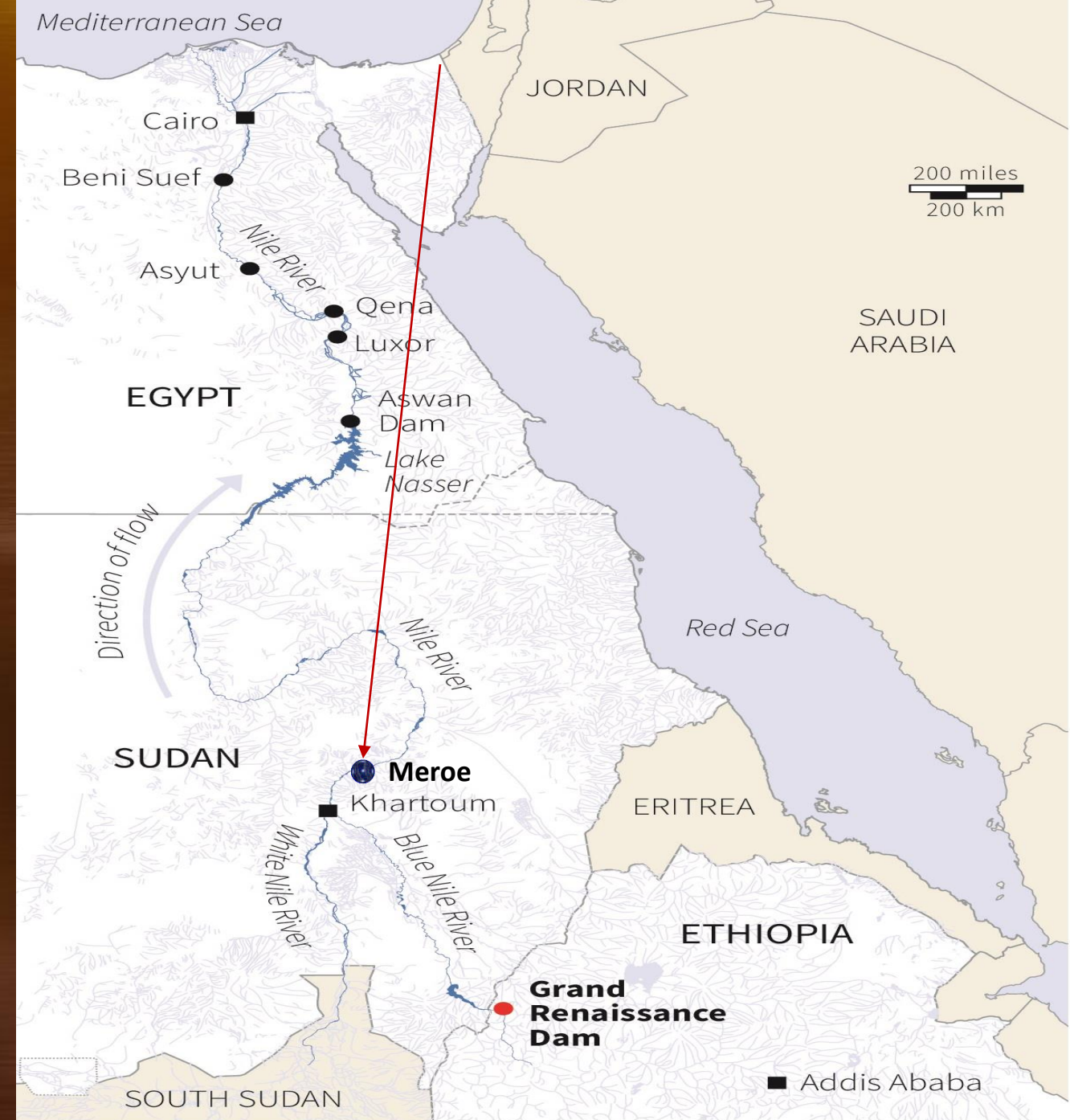
