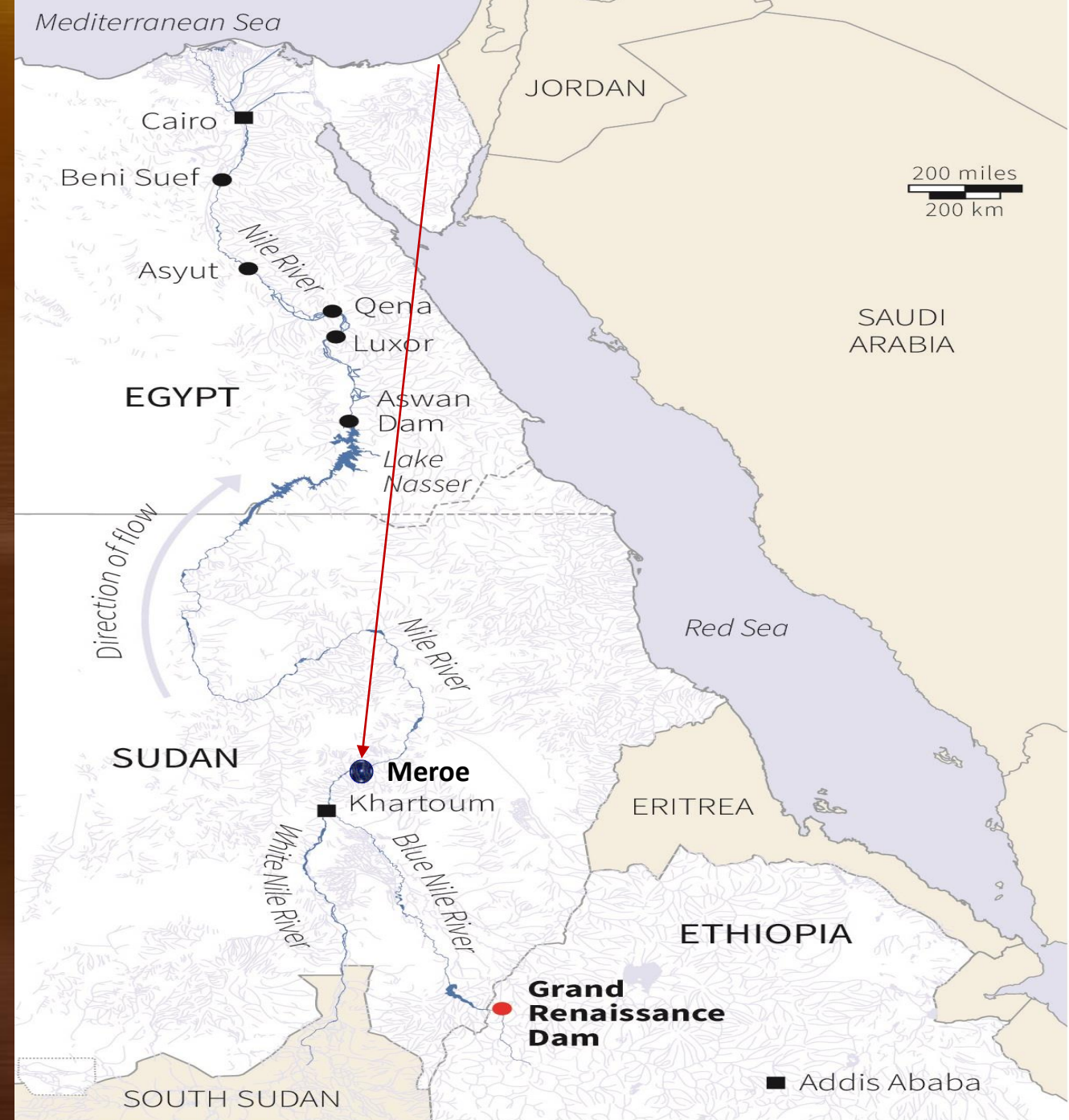

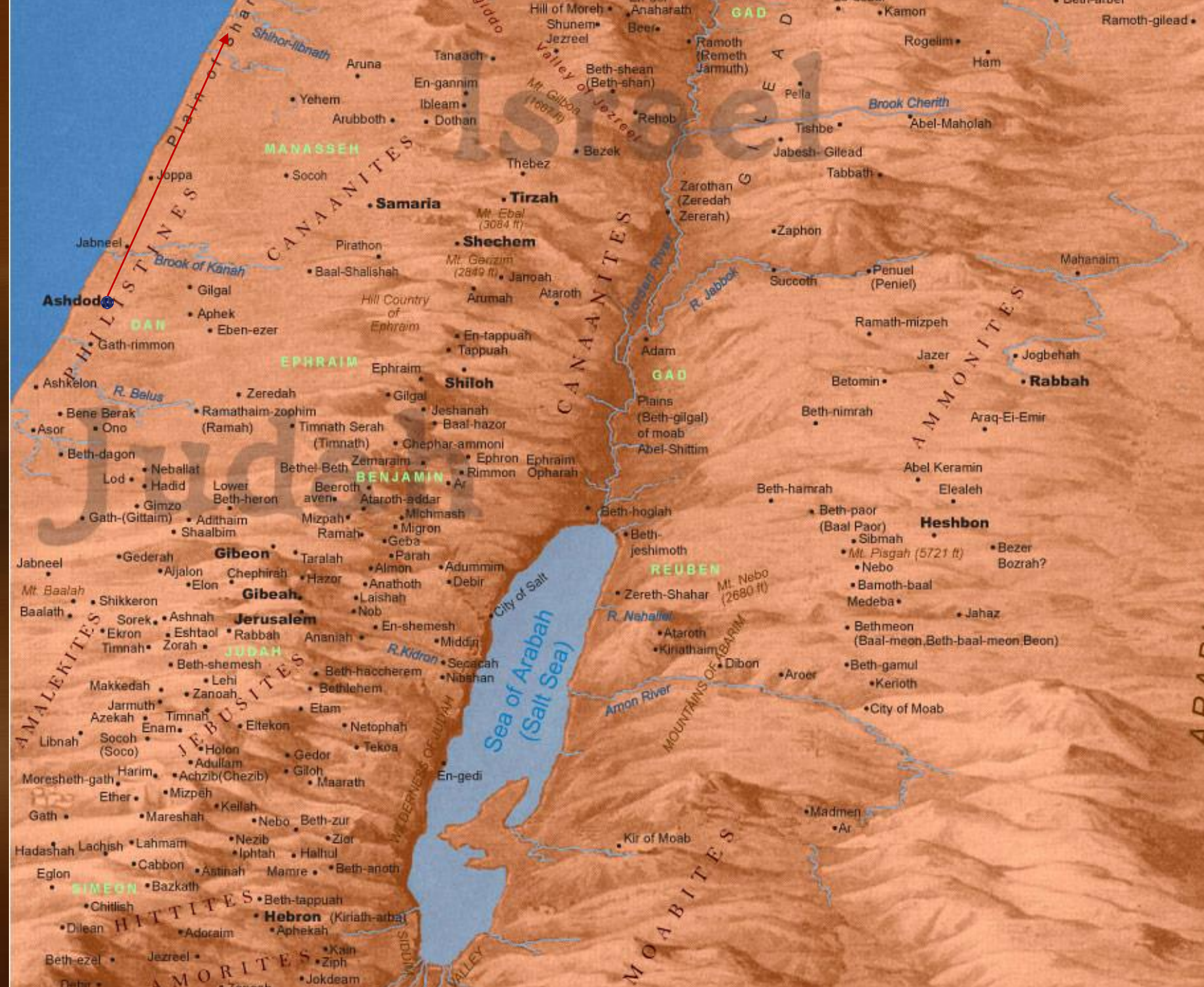

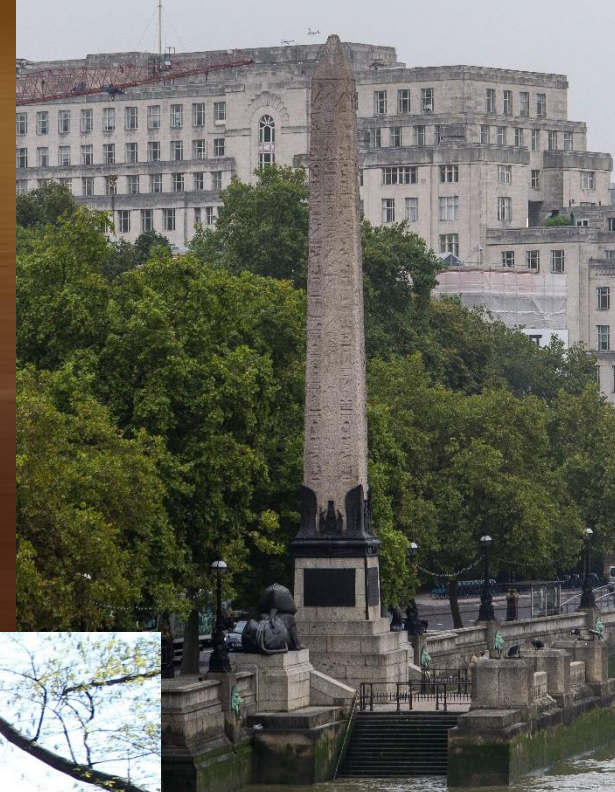

NT:2099

**euaggelistes** (yoo-ang-ghel-is-tace'); from NT:2097; a preacher of the gospel:  
KJV - evangelist.

NT:2097

**euaggelizo** (yoo-ang-ghel-id'-zo); from NT:2095 and NT:32; to announce good news ("evangelize") especially the gospel:  
KJV - declare, bring (declare, show) glad (good) tidings, preach (the gospel).

NT:2095

**eu** (yoo); neuter of a primary eus (good); (adverbially) well:  
KJV - good, well (done).

NT:32

**aggelos** (ang'-el-os); from aggello (to bring tidings); a messenger; especially an "angel"; by implication, a pastor:  
KJV - angel, messenger.
