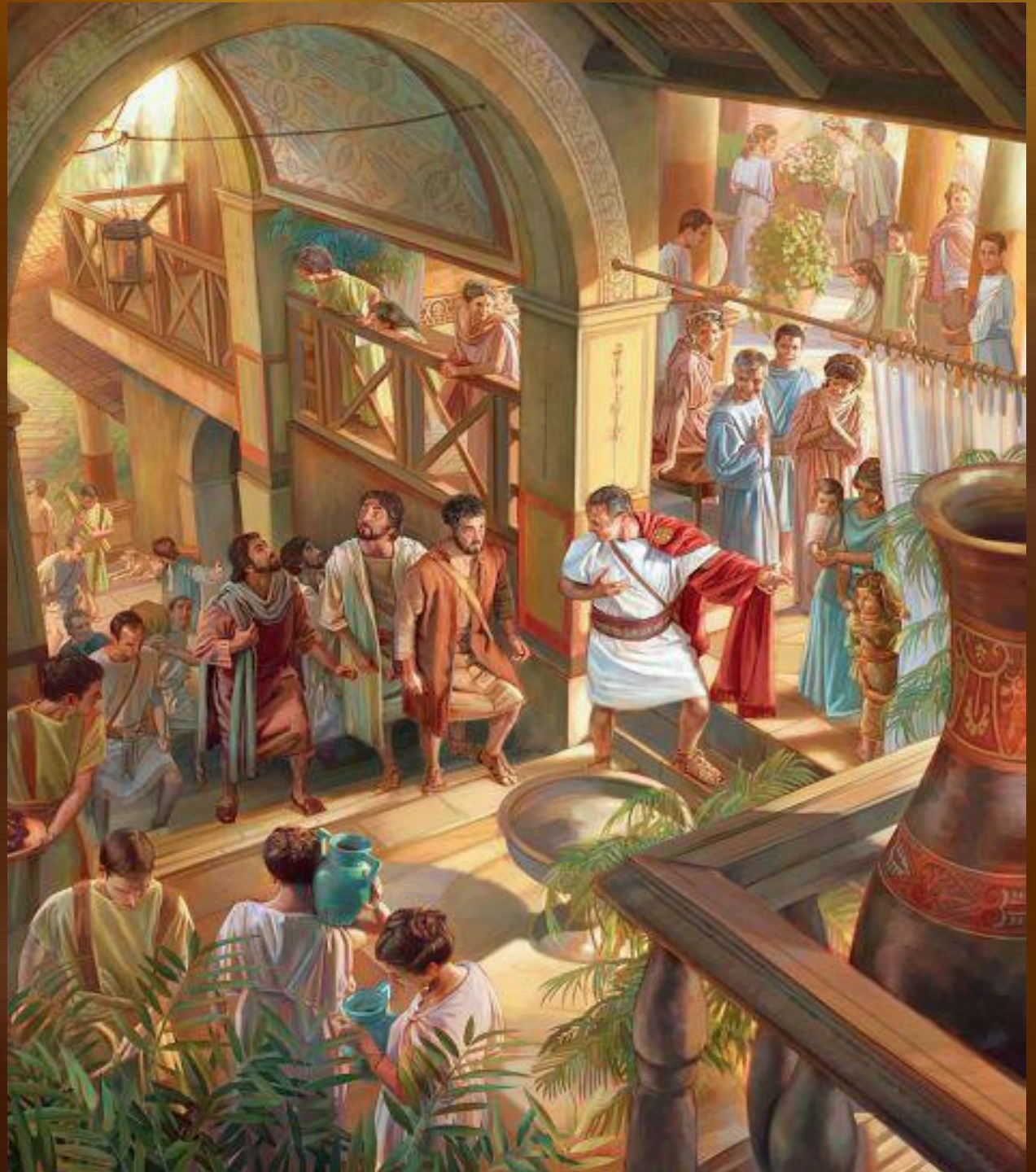

KJV - answer again, contradict, deny, gainsay (-er), speak against.

NT:369

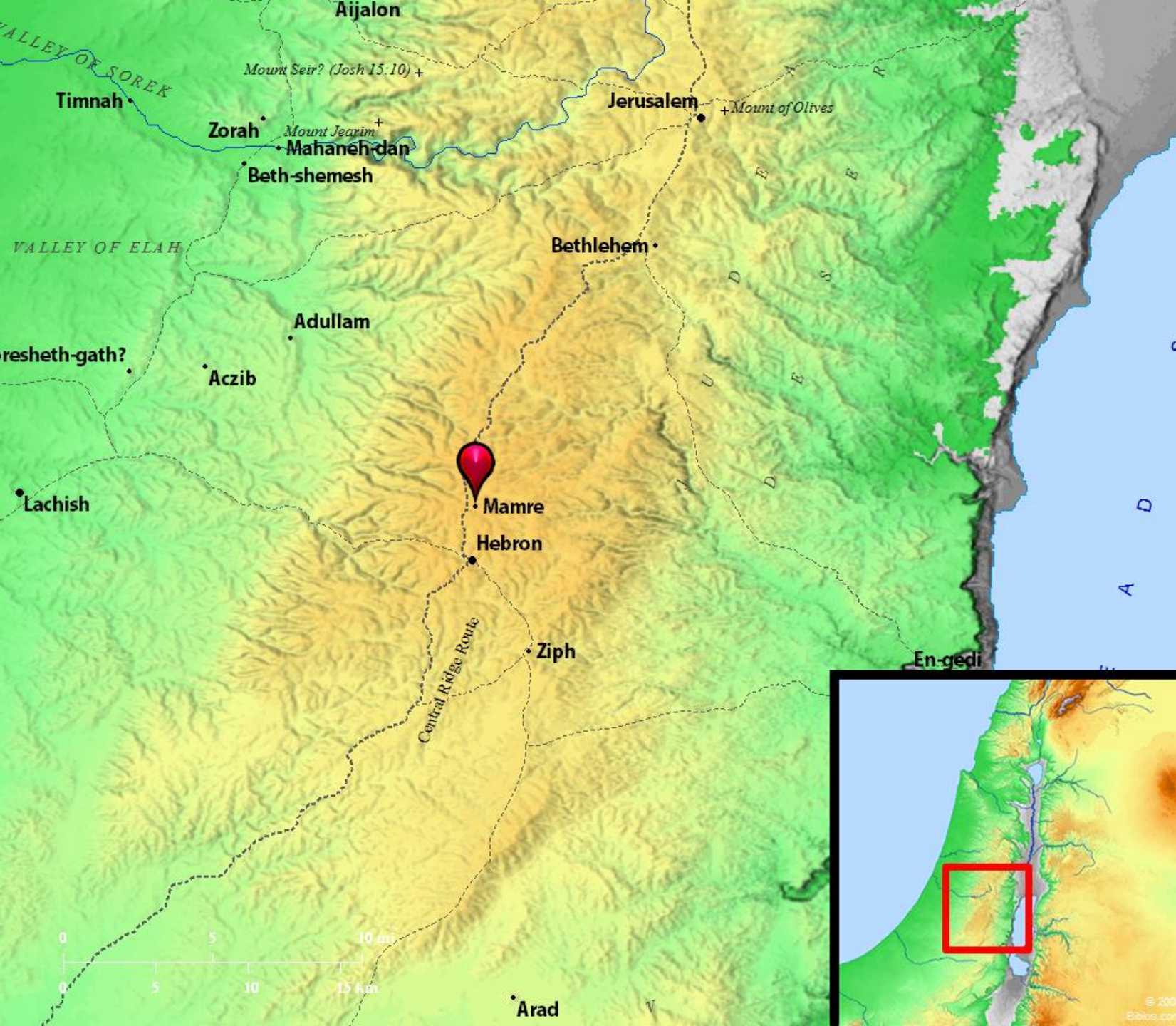
anantirrhotos (an-an-tir-hray'-toce); **promptly**:

KJV - without gainsaying.

NT:368

anantirrhotos (an-an-tir'-hray-tos); **indisputable**:

KJV - cannot be spoken against.

NT:1252

diakrino (dee-ak-ree'-no); to separate thoroughly, to withdraw from, or (by implication) oppose; figuratively, to discriminate (by implication, decide), or (reflexively) hesitate:

KJV - contend, make (to) differ (-ence), discern, doubt, judge, be partial, stagger, waver.

Held Their Peace

NT:2270

hesuchazo (hay-soo-khad'-zo); to keep still (intransitively), i.e. refrain from labor, meddlesomeness or speech:

KJV - cease, hold peace, be quiet, rest.

sigao (see-gah'-o); to keep silent (transitively or intransitively):

KJV - keep close (secret, silence), hold peace.

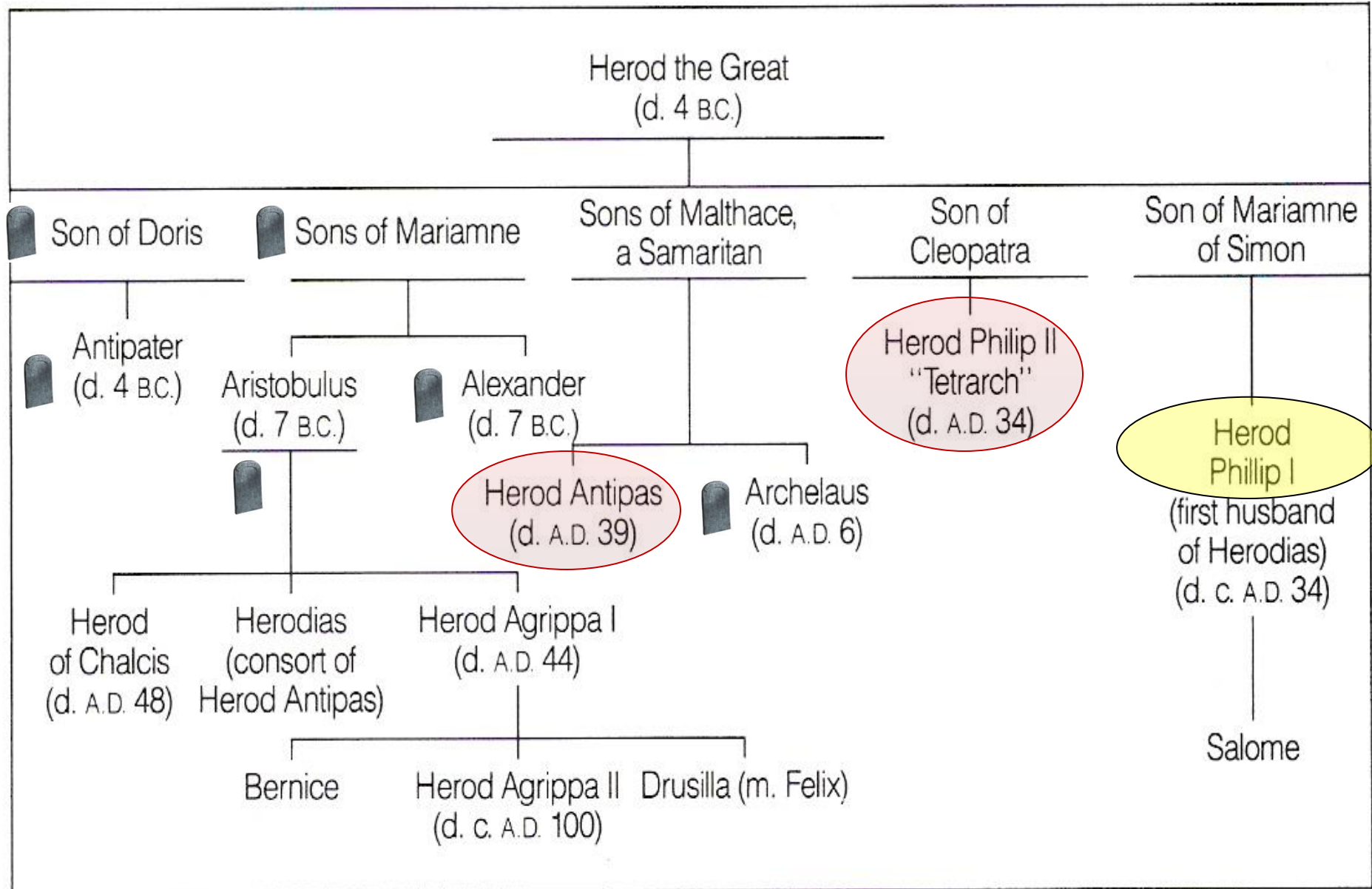
Family Tree of Herod



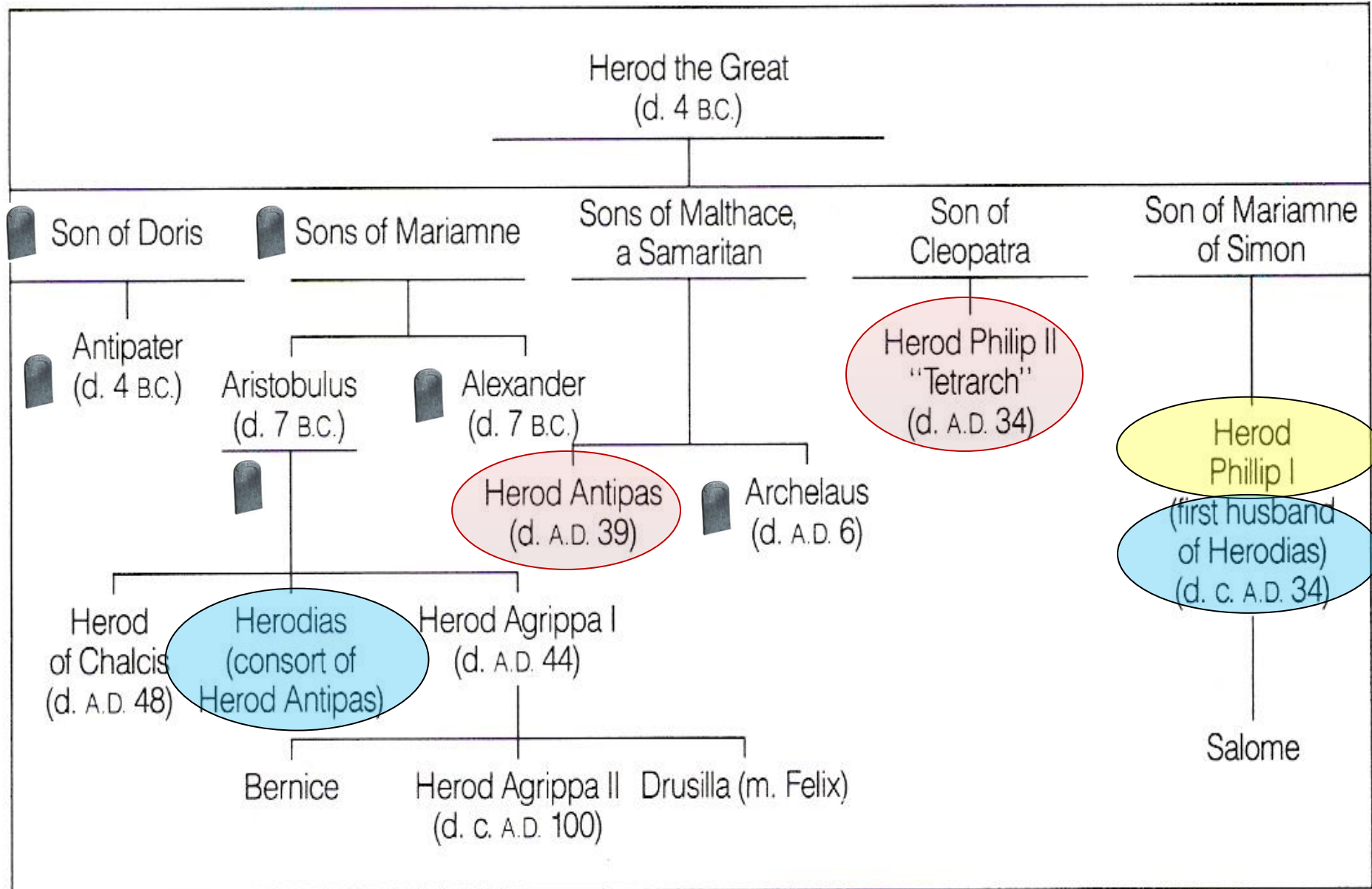

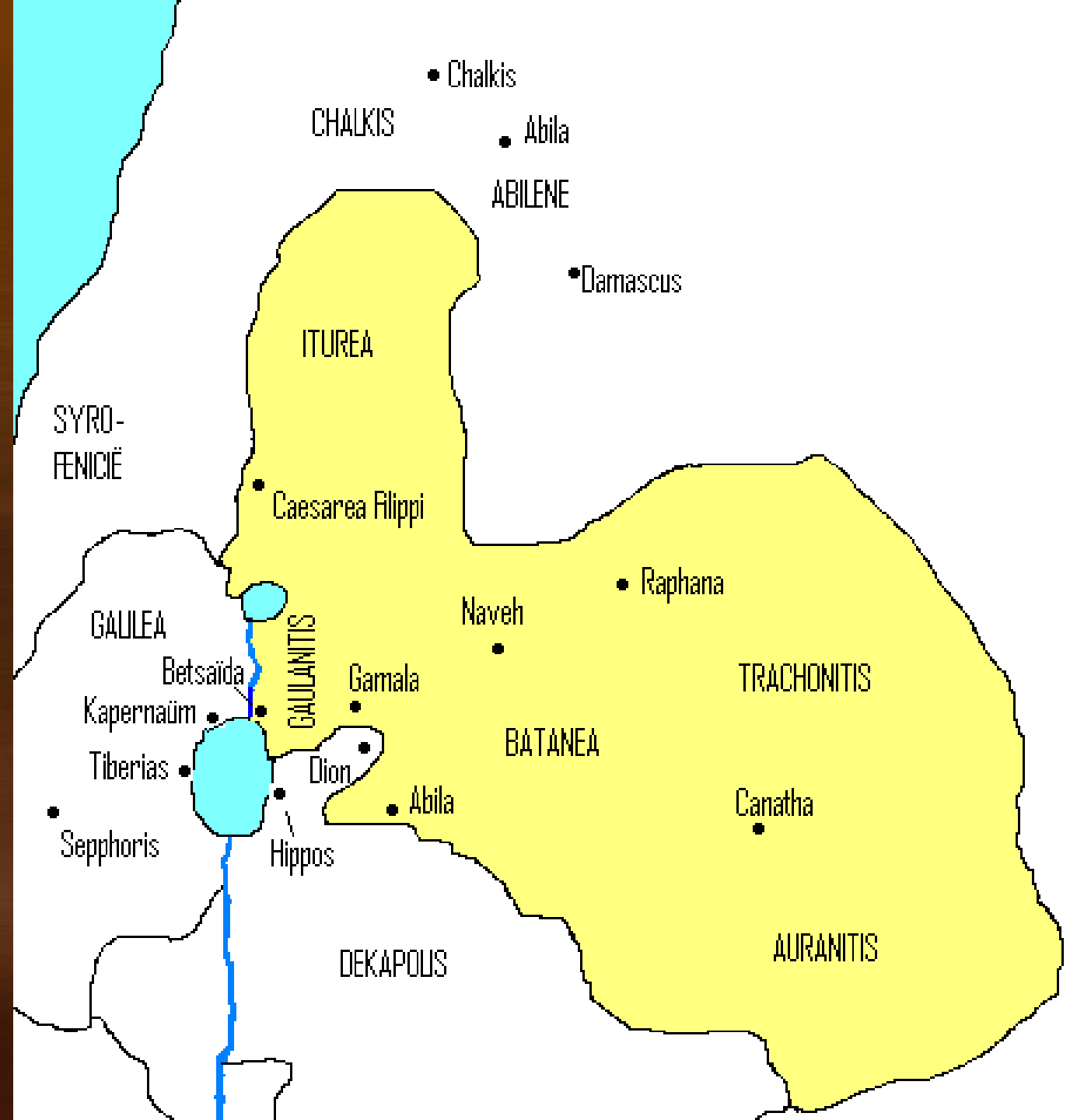
