


Hymn 265 - The Light of the World





- An ophthalmic surgeon gave Ron and Shelly a devastating diagnoses. Ron had cancer in his left eye. The only chance was to remove the eye before the cancer could spread to his brain.
- Ron's eye was removed and while he was recovering the Lord gave one of his most beloved songs.
- The cancer had not spread and as he continued to do evangelistic services with his father-in-law Dr. Garlock, kids began to call him a pirate. One young man called him "Patch the Pirate."

- This ministry really started in In 1979 Ron and Shelly writing children's music for their home church and later being released in an album.
- In 1982, Ron added a comedy scrip to their music and released "Patch the Pirate Goes to Space." The first of over 41 annual Patch albums. In all, Patch the Pirate albums have sold over 2 million copies.







- In 2013 Ron and Shelly lost their oldest son Johnathan.

- Johnathan took his own life. A devastating loss to his family, church, and the body of Christ as a whole.


