Contention

NT:3948

paroxusmos (par-ox-oos-mos'); from NT:3947 ("paroxysm"); incitement (to good), or dispute (in anger):

KJV - contention, provoke unto.

NT:3947

paroxuno (par-ox-oo'-no); to sharpen alongside, i.e.
(figuratively) to exasperate:

KJV - easily provoke, stir.









Conflict Resolution

- 1. Go before God until you get his prospective on the conflict. (II Tim 3:12)
- 2. Remember God is bigger than any problem.
- 3. Act in the "opposite spirit". (Rom 12:17-21)
- 4. Read Proverbs until you know it backwards.
- 5. Study how to say things. How something is worded is vitally important. (Prov. 15:1)

Conflict Resolution

- 6. Do not use emotion, forceful language, or legal sounding terms. (Prov. 12:18)
- 7. Do not be too harsh or absolute. (Prov. 25:15)
- 8. Act soon and keep it small. (Prov. 17:14)
- 9. Avoid angry and easily disturbed people. If possible keep them out of the process. (Prov. 15:18 & 29:22)

Conflict Resolution

10. Pay attention to the moral character of the people involved. Rely on people of integrity and faithfulness to help you in peacemaking. (Prov. 28:25 & 26)

11. Do not forget that in many Christian circles many conflicts have the "Accuser" as their cause (Eph. 6:10-21)

12. Be strong and courageous on the basis of God's word. (Josh 1:889)






