# THE CENTER OF ATHENIAN LIFE

**The Acropolis**, a fortified hill, stood above the center of Athens. The ancient Greeks built the Parthenon and other temples on the hill.

**The Agora**, or market place, was Athens' civic center. It lay at the foot of the Acropolis. As it appeared about A.D. 51, it included *stoas*, which had shops and meeting places; the *Odeion*, a theater; and government buildings such as the *Bouleuterion*, *Metroön*, and *Tholos*.



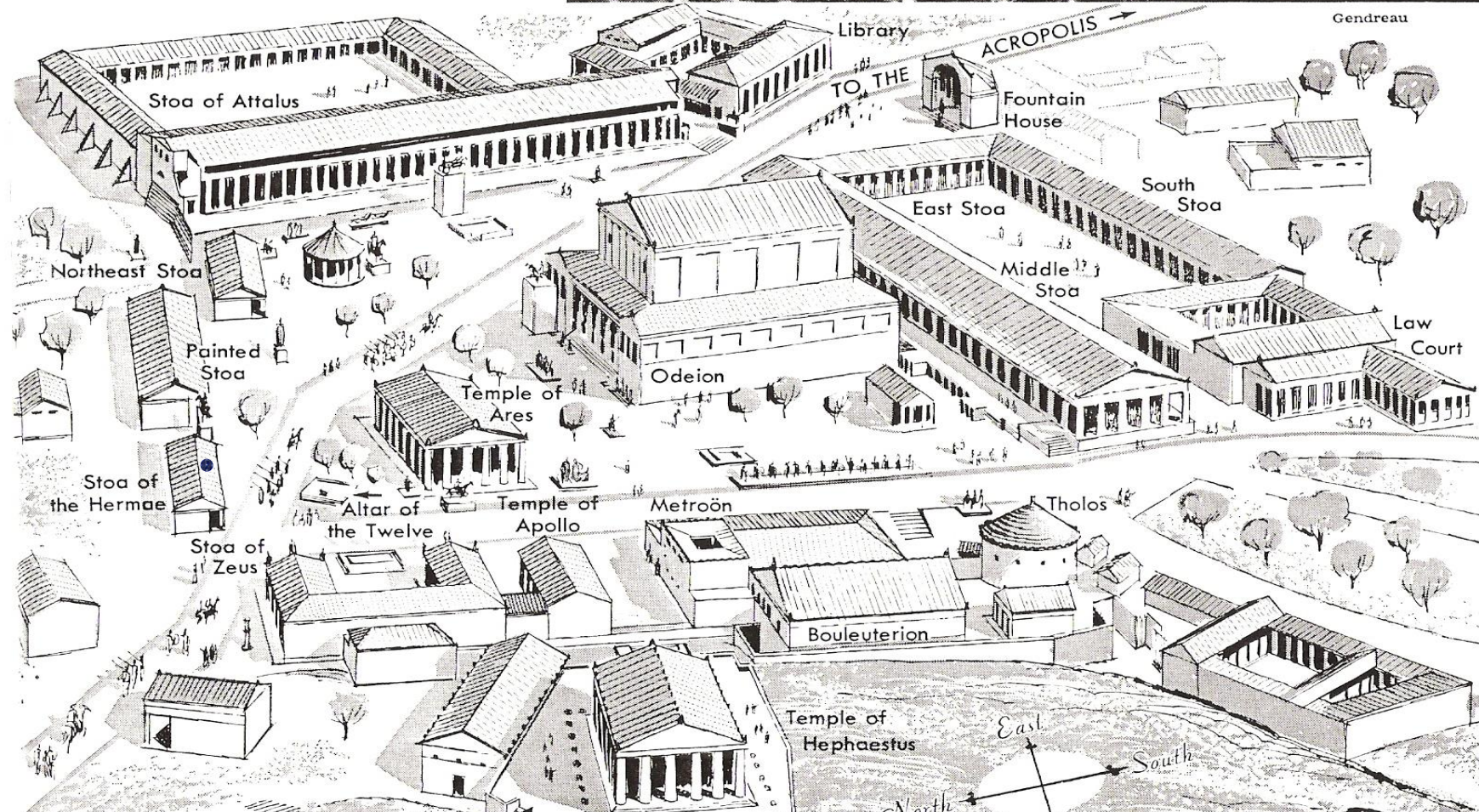
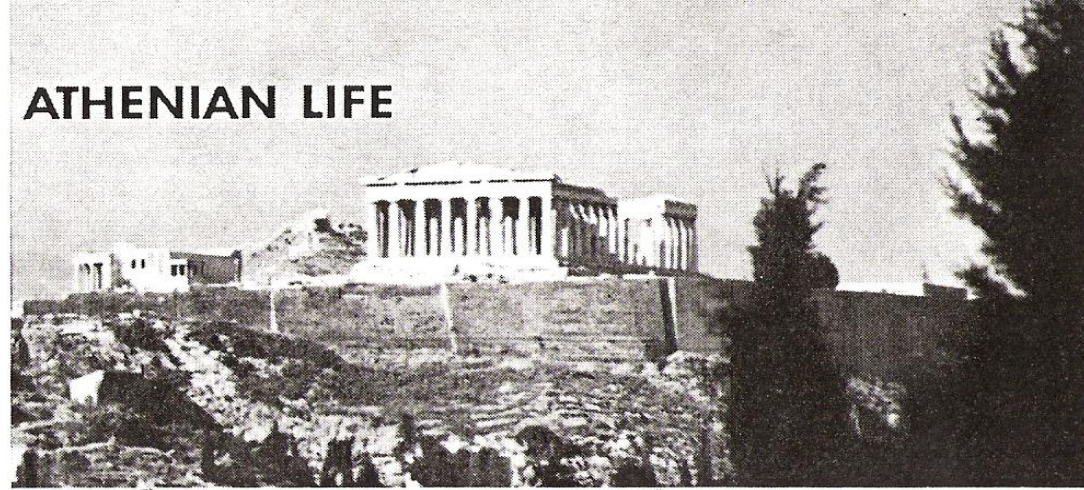
