Rosetta Stone

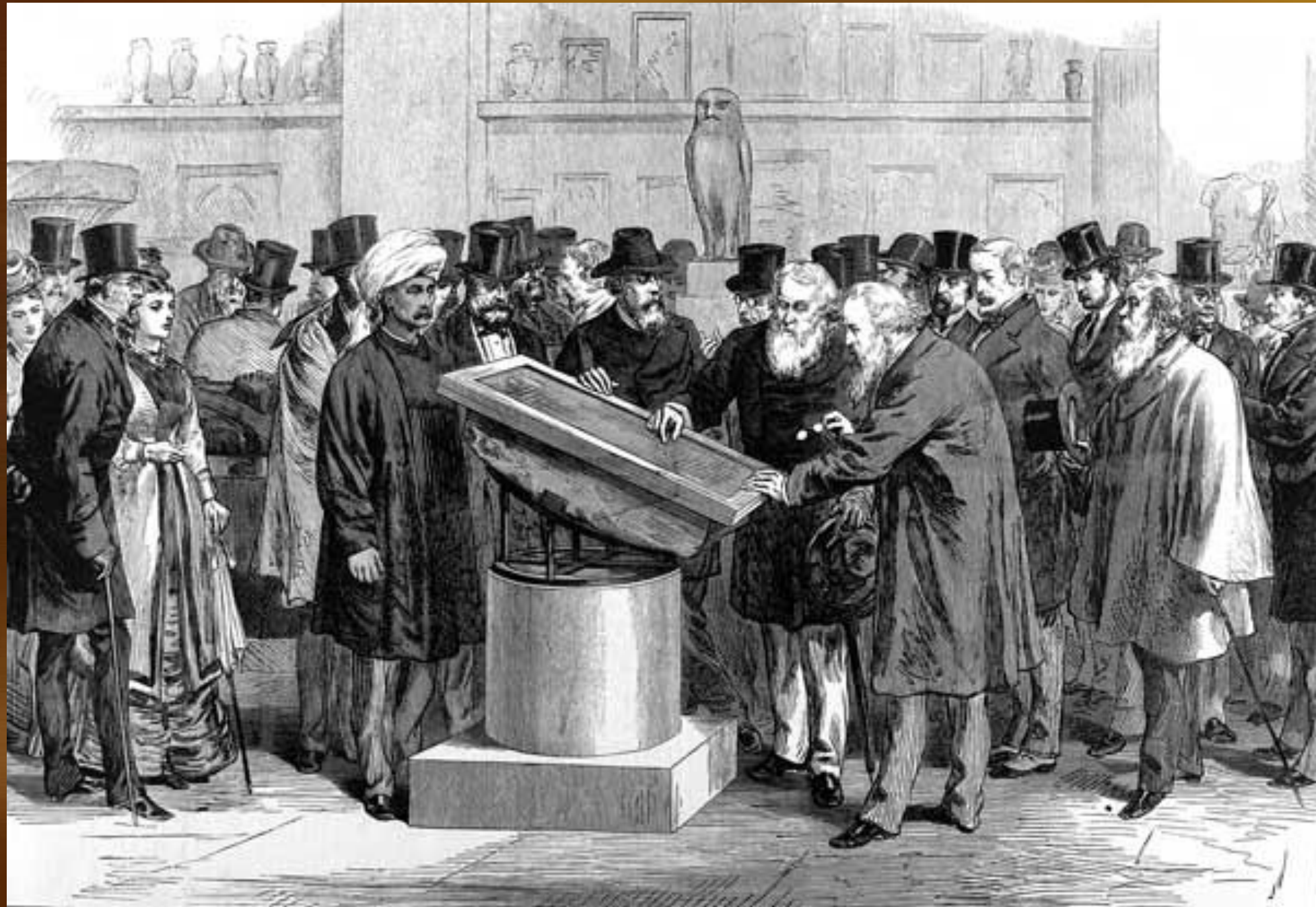
196 BC – Stele Created

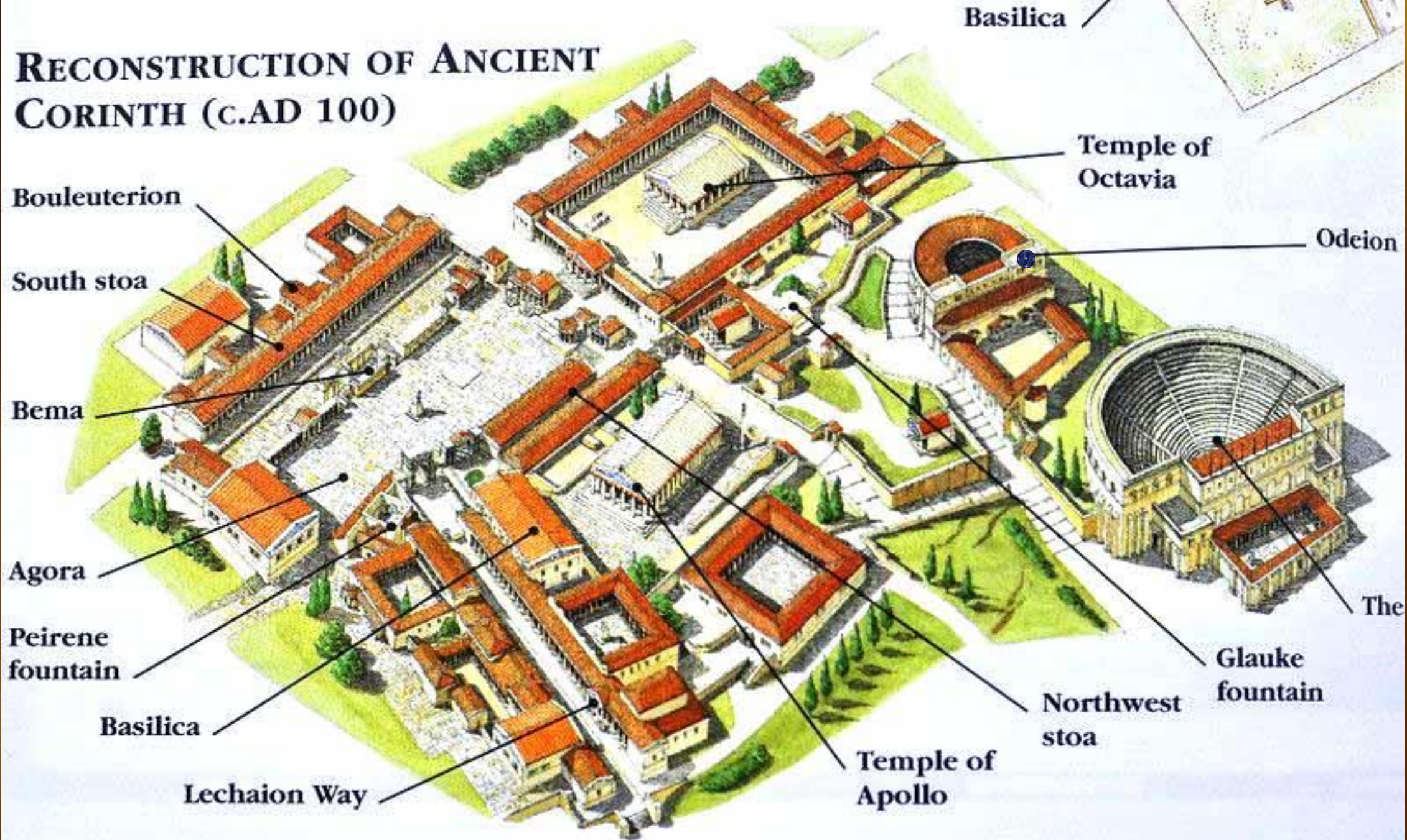
