60 feet high

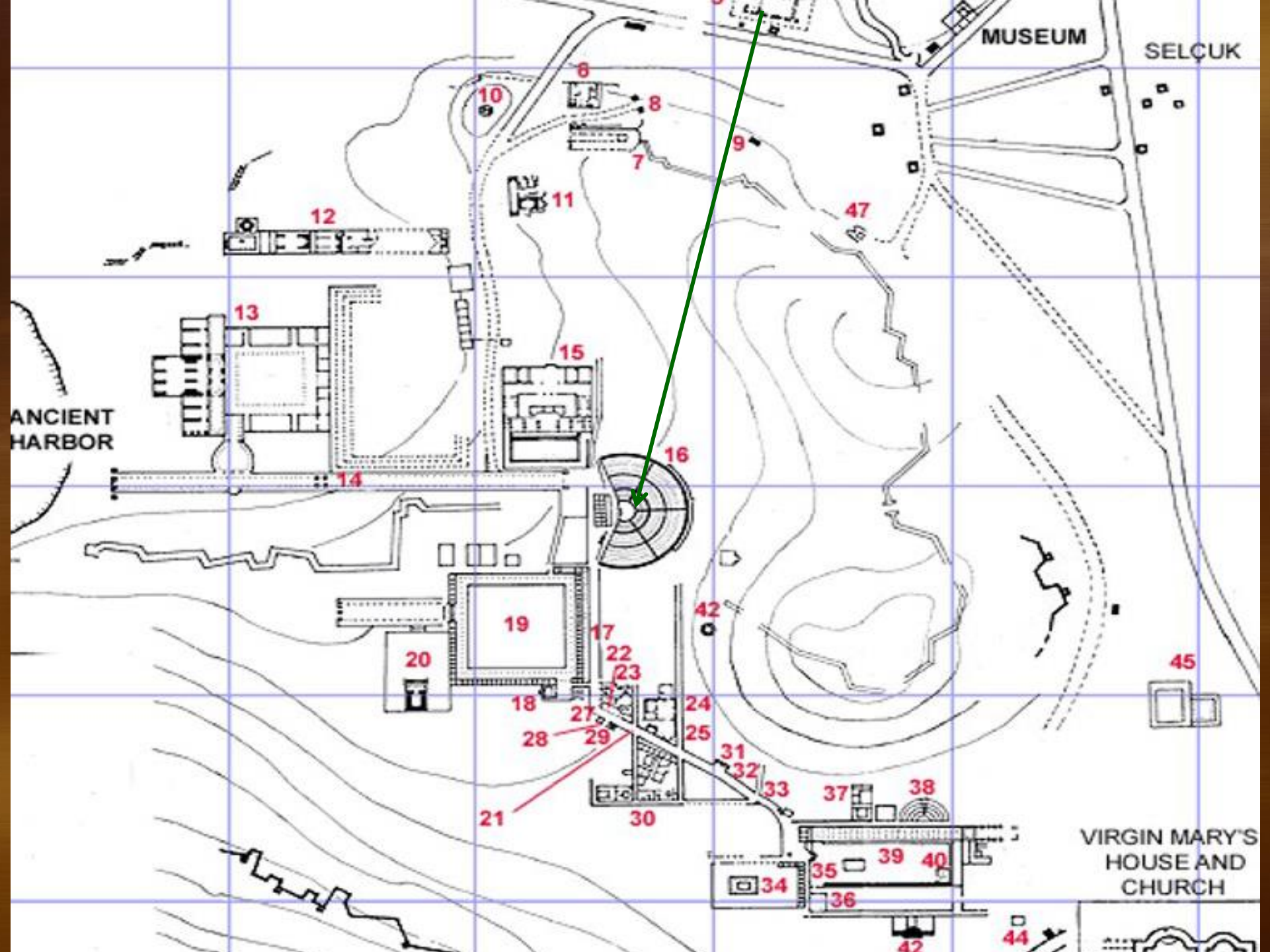

Christian



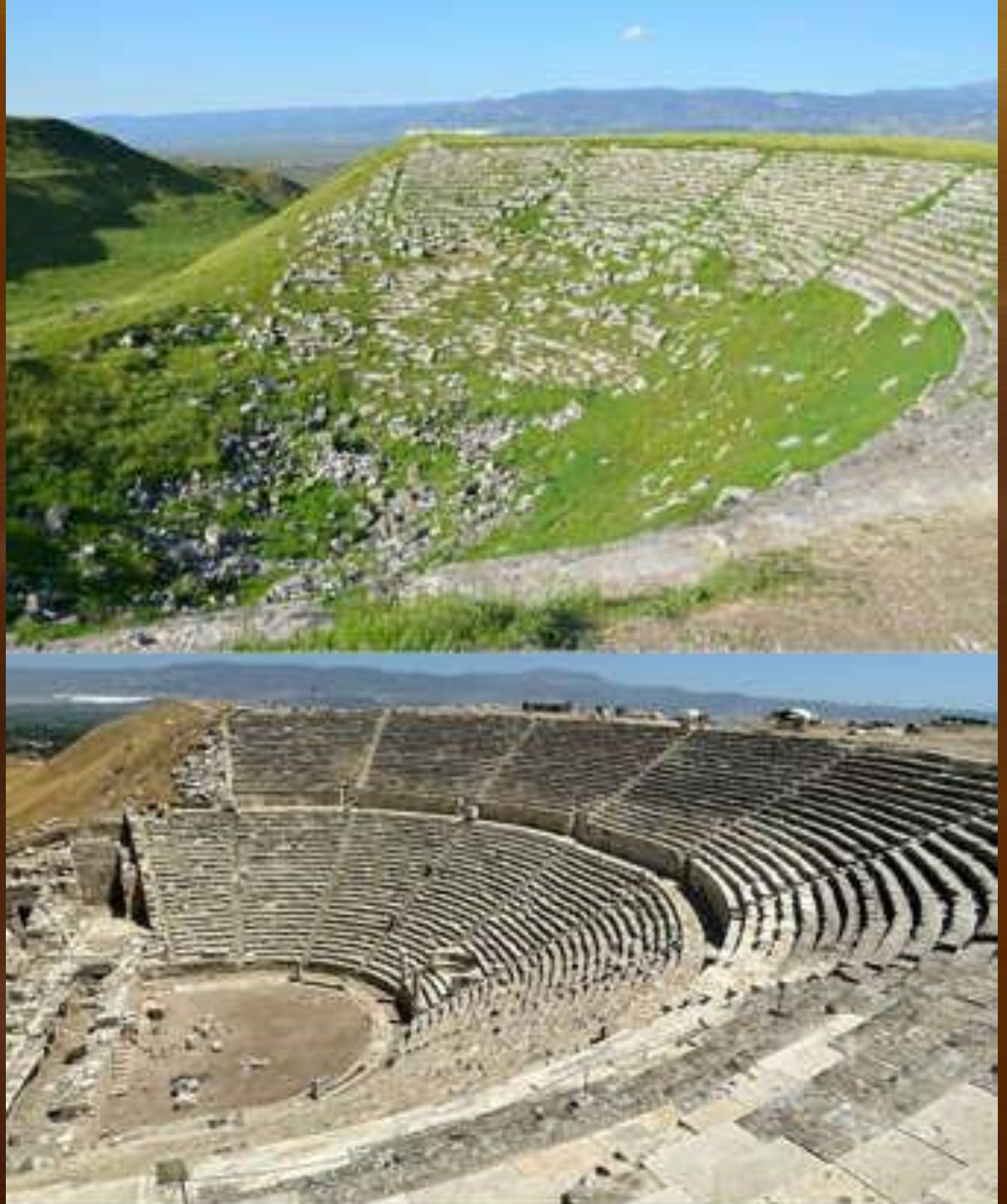

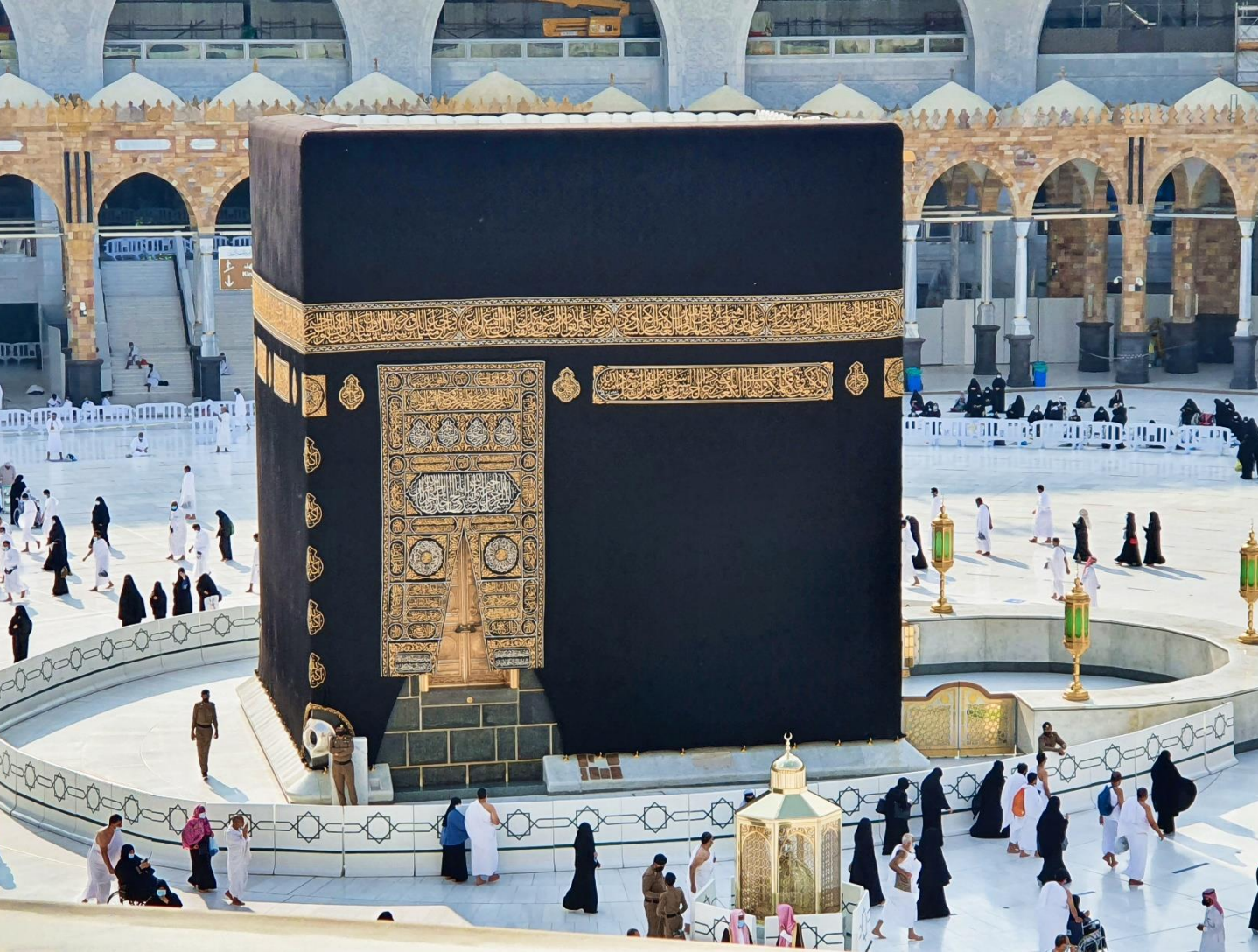

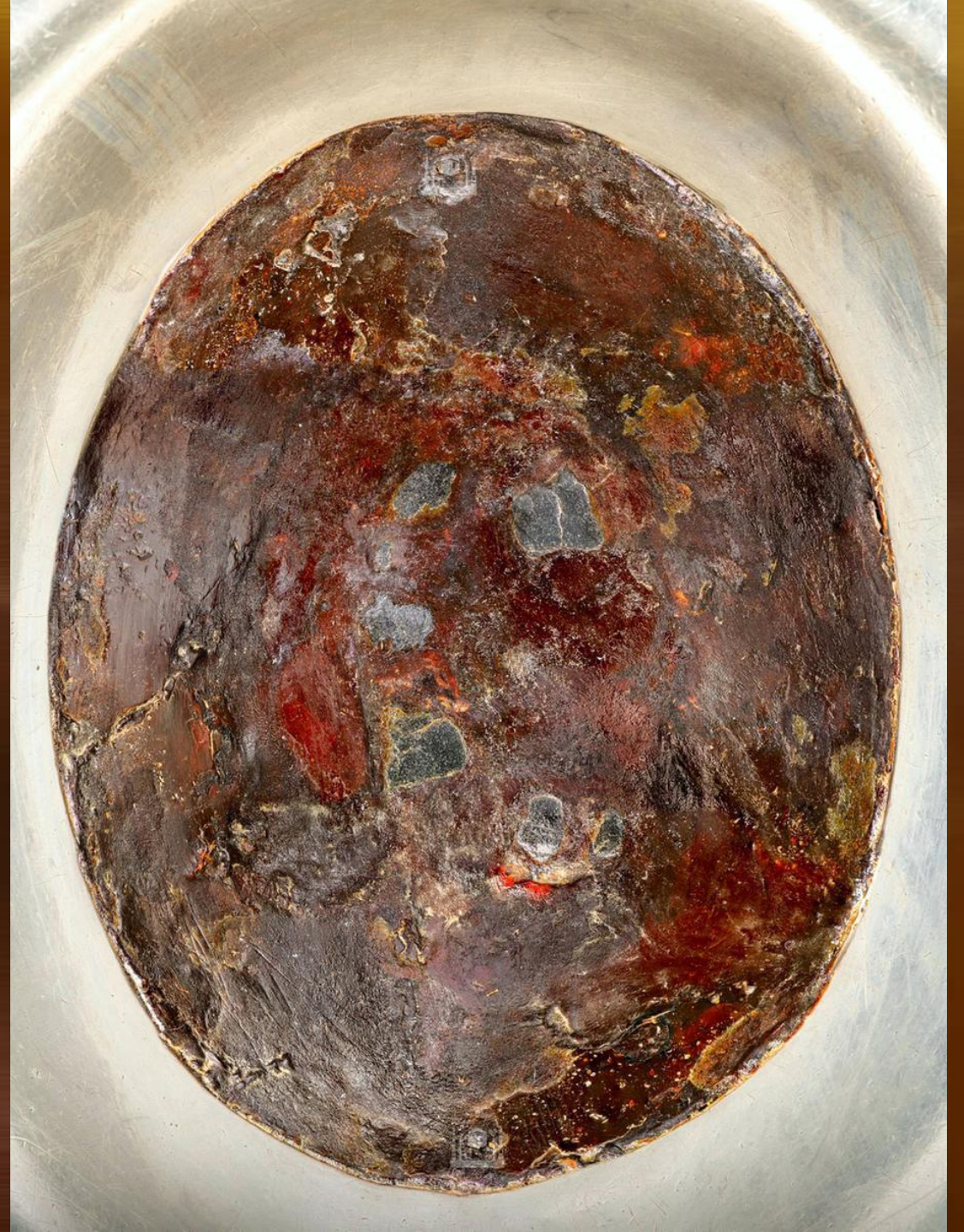
