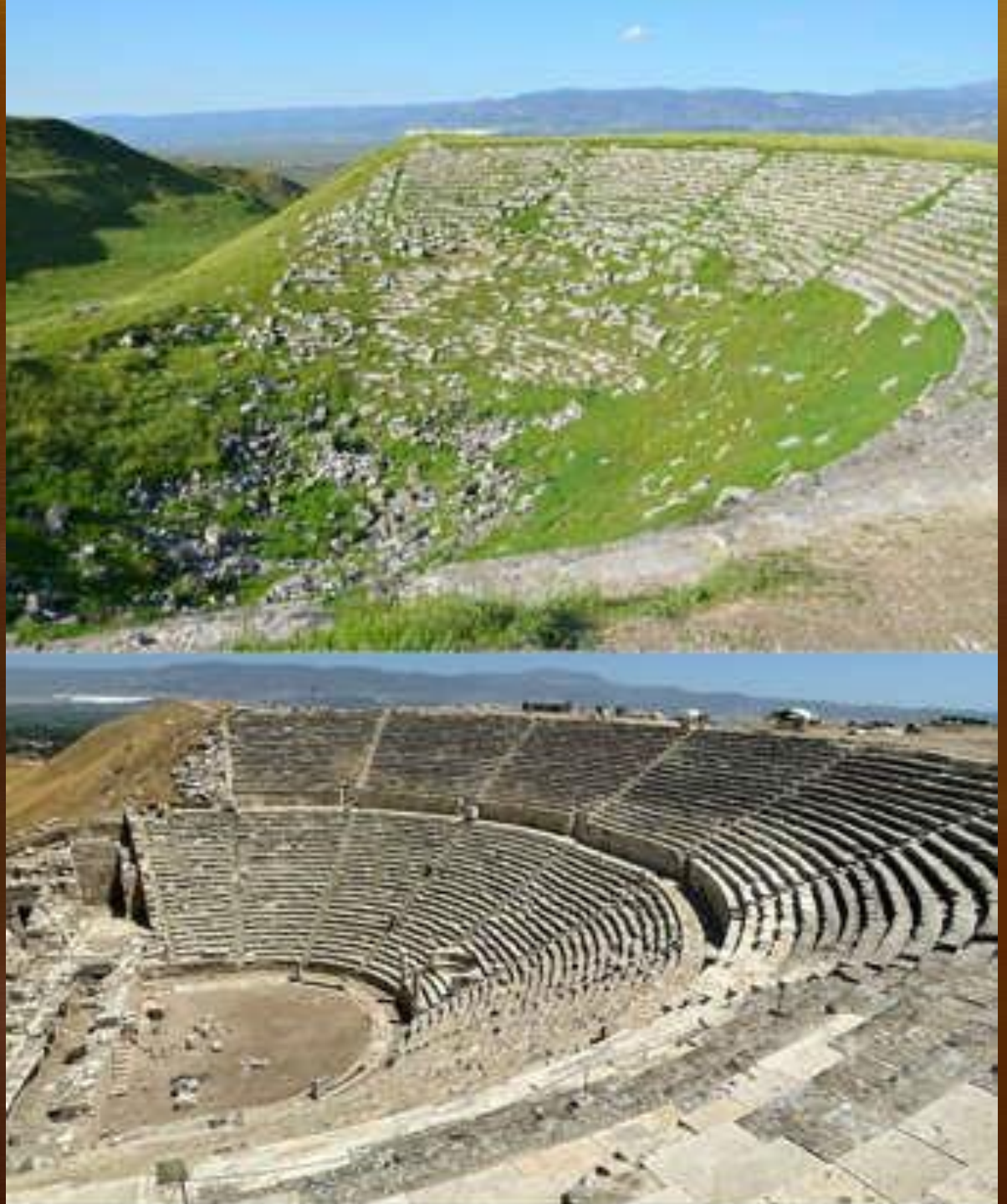

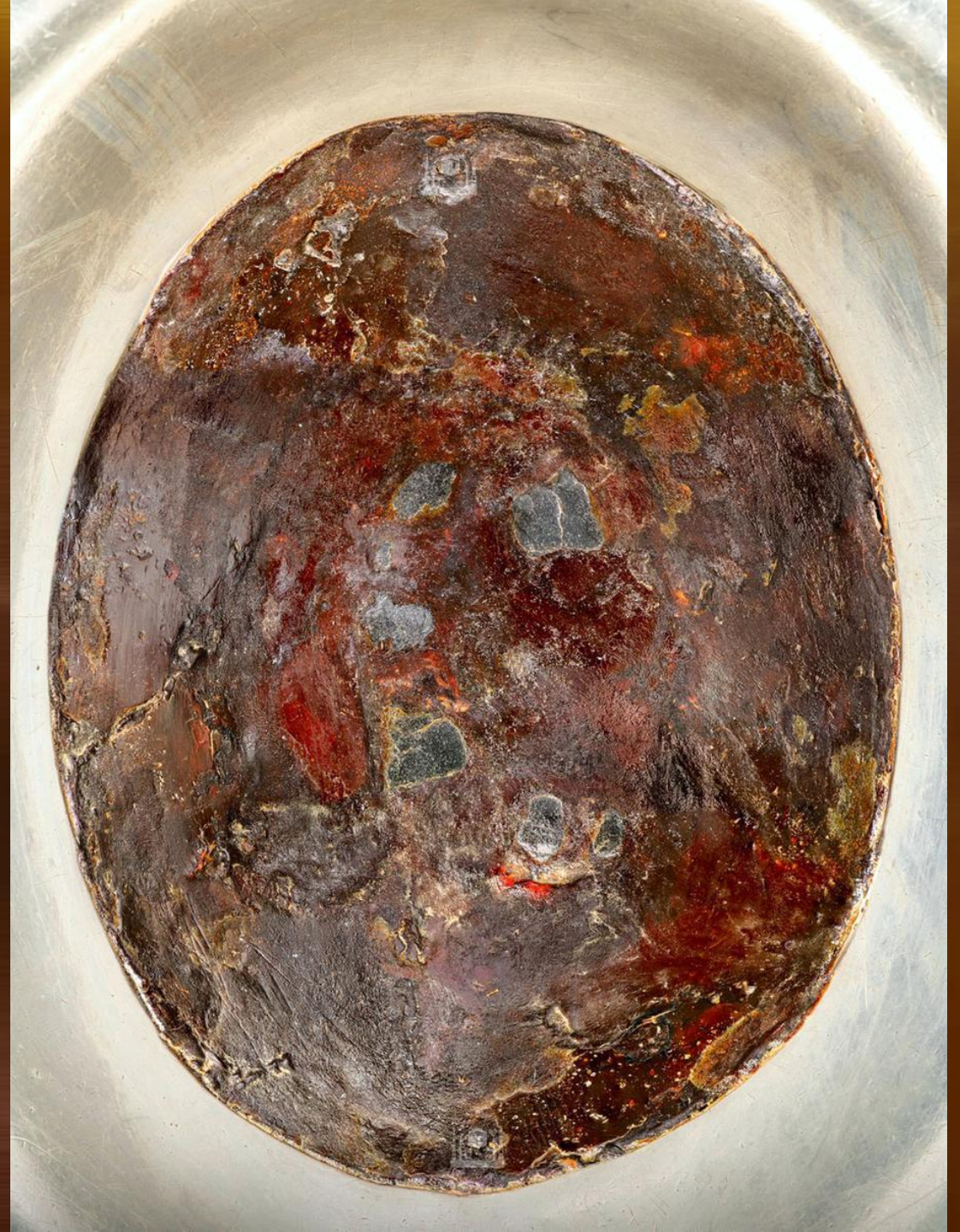

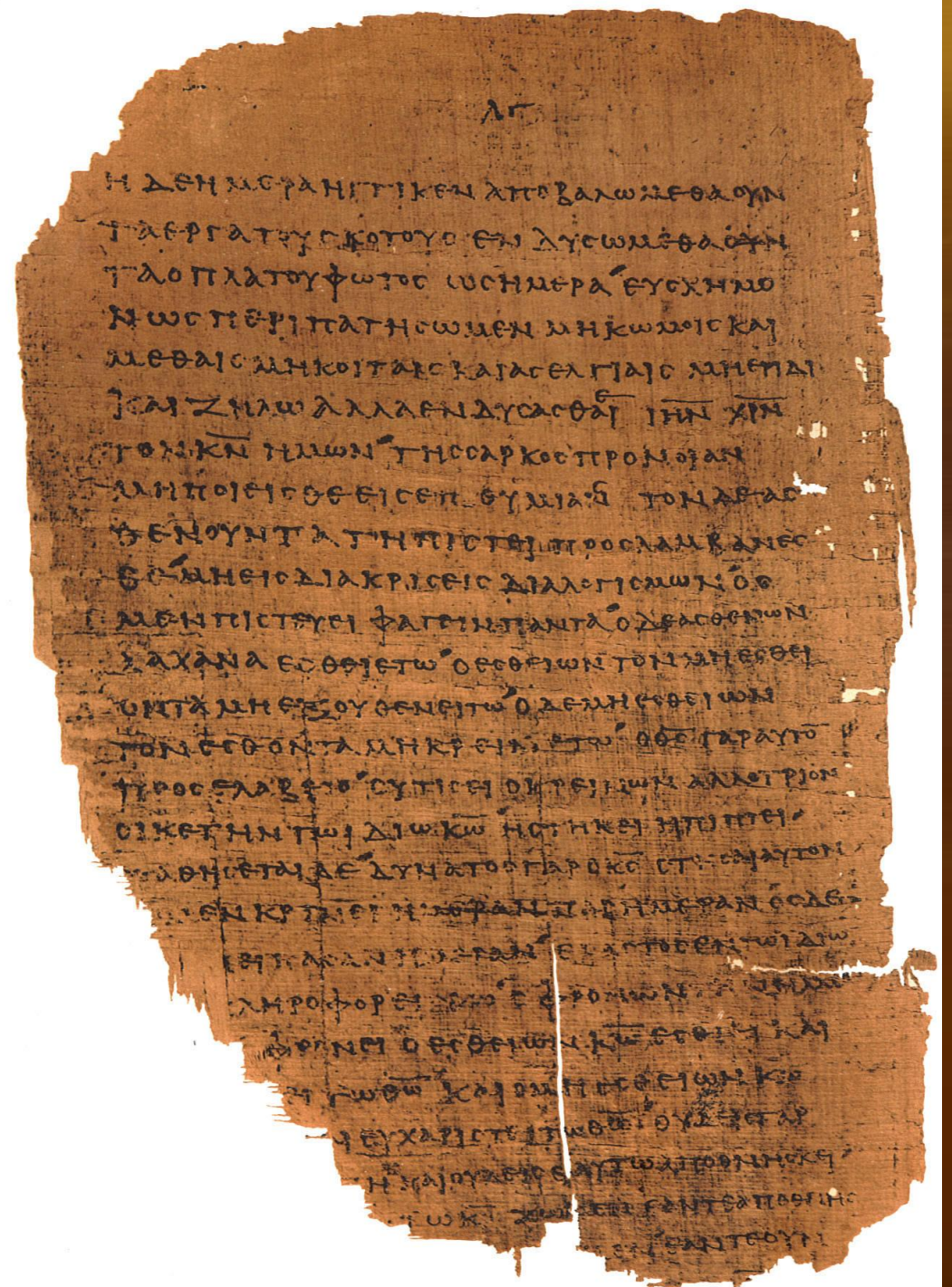

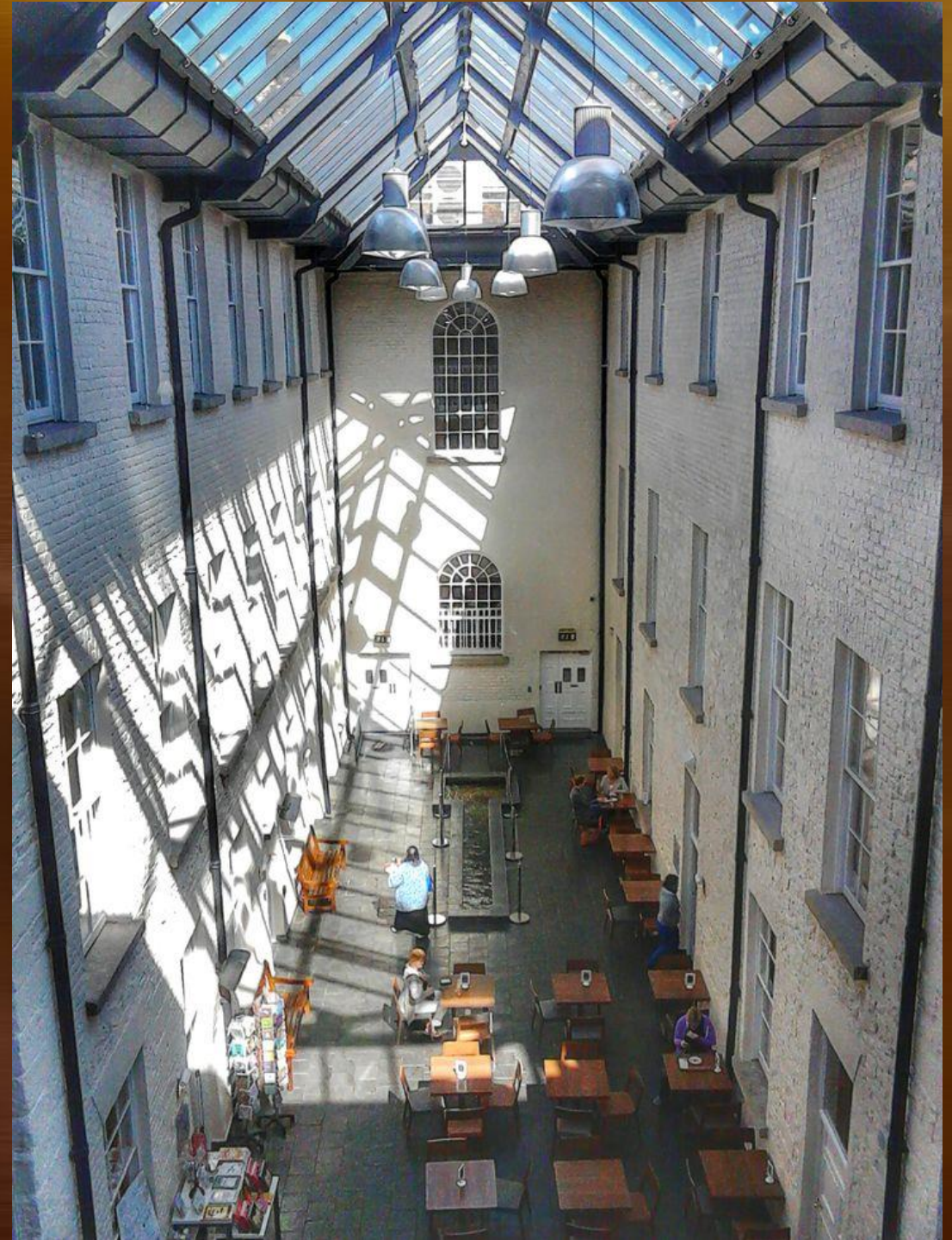

The Golden Age of Ephesus

Entrance to Ephesus from the Harbor

Entrance to Ephesus from the Magnesian

Architectural reconstruction of the harbor entrance area, featuring a large semi-circular theater (24) and a series of buildings (25-31) along the waterfront. A compass rose is located in the upper center of the image.
