
NT:4892 Sunedrion (soon-ed'-ree-on); compound of NT:4862 and the base of NT:1476; a joint session, i.e. (specifically) the Jewish Sanhedrin; by analogy, a subordinate tribunal: KJV - council.

NT:4862 Sun (soon); a primary preposition denoting union; with or together, i.e. by association, companionship, process, resemblance, possession, instrumentality, addition, etc.: KJV - beside, with





- Joseph ben Caiaphas (18–36) who had married the daughter of Annas
- Jonathan ben Annas (36–37 and 44)
- Theophilus ben Annas (37–41)
- Matthias ben Annas (43)
- Ananus ben Annas (63)

Ananias ben Neabedeus was the Jewish high priest from AD 48 to 59

### Council

NT:4892 Sunedrion (soon-ed'-ree-on); neuter of a presumed derivative of a compound of NT:4862 and the base of NT:1476; a joint session, i.e. (specifically) the Jewish Sanhedrin; by analogy, a subordinate tribunal: KJV - council.

NT:4862 **Sun** (soon); a primary preposition denoting union; with or together, i.e. by association, companionship, process, resemblance, possession, instrumentality, addition, etc.:

KJV - beside, with

### gods

OT:430

**elohiym** (el-o-heem'); gods in the ordinary sense; but specifically used (in the plural thus, especially with the article) of the supreme God; occasionally applied by way of deference to magistrates; and sometimes as a superlative:

KJV - angels, exceeding, God (gods)- dess, -ly), (very) great, judges, mighty.
