





# Conspiracy

NT:4945 **Sunomasia** (soon-o-mos-ee'-ah); from a compound of **NT:4862** and **NT:3660**; a swearing together, i.e. (by implication) a plot:  
KJV - conspiracy.

NT:4862 **Sun** (soon); a primary preposition denoting union; with or together, i.e. by association, companionship, process, resemblance, possession, instrumentality, addition, etc.:  
KJV - beside, with

NT:3660 **Omnuo** (om-noo'-o); a prolonged form of a primary but obsolete omo, for which another prolonged form (omoo (om-o'-o)) is used in certain tenses; to swear, i.e. take (or declare on) oath:  
KJV - swear.

# Curse

NT:332

**anathematizo** (an-ath-em-at-id'-zo); from NT:331; to declare or vow under penalty of execration:

KJV - (bind under a) curse, bind with an oath.

NT:331


**anathema** (an-ath'-em-ah); a (religious) ban or (concretely) excommunicated (thing or person):

KJV - accused, anathema, curse, great.


